### FRENCH SENATORS QUARREL OVER ST. PIERRE TROUBLES

PARIS, Dec. 21.—There was an animated incident this morning during a session of the Colonial Budget regarding the recent rioting by the people of St. Pierre, Miq., over the question of free schools. One feature of the demonstration was the raising of the American flag. M. Millie, Minister of the Colonies, explained that owing to the clearly defined Separatist movement at St. Pierre he has given the local governor instructions to be firm but conciliatory.

Senator Delahaye, protested with energy against the suspicious cast on the patriotism of the inhabitants of the island and charged that the manifestations were an outgrowth of the persecution of the "free schools."

M. Delahaye was interrupted by a senator who called attention to the fact that the people of St. Pierre had raised an American flag to which he replied that this had been done because the American flag was the symbol of liberty.

"No such incident has ever occurred in the older colonies," declared Senator Zyceron of Guadeloupe.

"The reason is," M. Delahaye said,

"that the colonies are inhabited only by negroes."

Amid a storm of protestation Senator Lintelhae shouted, "We should think of the color of the flag and not the color of the colonists."

The Senator then demanded the recall of the French warship sent out to St. Pierre, Miq., but the Colonial Minister refused that in view of disturbances her presence was necessary for the maintenance of the prestige of the flag. A motion to increase the St. Pierre appropriation by \$4,000 was finally adopted by the Senate.

### PASTOR TELLS GIRLS TO PAINT AND POWDER

ST. LOUIS, December 20.—Young women of the First M. E. Church may now use the powder puff, like-wise the paint brush and the brow pencil without any compunctions of conscience. Their pastor, the Rev. Philip Cone Fletcher, says it is all right.

Lecturing on "Love, Courtship and Marriage," he told them that beauty was a duty and that if they had not been born that way it was incumbent upon them to powder and paint and pencil themselves beautiful.

"If I were a young woman I would try to be winsome," he said. "Beauty is a duty. Young women ought to strive to appear to the very best advantage, mentally, physically and morally. If by the use of the powder puff the paint brush and the brow pencil you can make yourself more winsome, you have my consent to use them, freely. It is all right to supplement the works of God. To be ugly in an age like this is but little short of a sin against God and self."

He said: "I take the position that lovers should be sincere and honest with each other. Deceptive courtship means a miserable marriage. No woman can be happy with the man who has lied to win her. No man can honor and cherish the woman who caught him as the spider catches the unsuspecting fly."

"There are several fallacies about love that ought to be corrected. One is that the first love is the only true love. The first love may be a true love, but it need not be the only true love. Another fallacy is that love is blind. Love can see beauties where the world sees deformities. It is also a mistake to suppose that one can love truly but once. It is likewise false that true love never runs smooth. What kind does run smooth then? And an error equally as great as the others is the one which says, 'true love can never die.' Love will die if it is not fed."

### BURNING OIL SHIP RIDDLED AND SUNK

SINGAPORE, Dec. 21.—The burning oil ship Kalam Kaloma, was bombarded by the harbor fort and sank with her hull riddled with solid shot. The flaming steamer, which hails from England, arrived in Singapore, from New York, two days ago, with her cargo of oil on fire. All attempts to extinguish the blaze was useless. It is impossible to go near the vessel because of the possibility of explosion and finally the harbor agents appealed to the commander of the fort. The gunners, at a distance of two miles, sank the craft with their six inch guns.

DUNKIRK, N. Y., Dec. 21.—William Ives, one hundred and five years old died at his home in Fredonia, yesterday, after a brief illness. He was born in Greenwich, England, and came to the United States when a young man. He voted in sixteen presidential elections. He was a vegetarian and never required the services of a doctor until within the last few months. He retained full possession of all his faculties to the end.

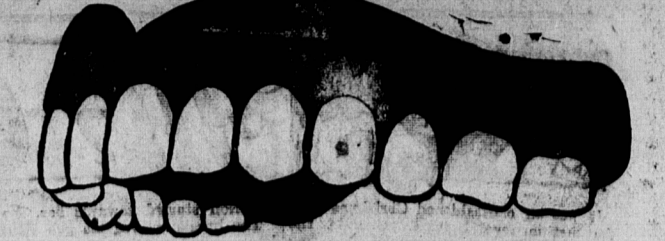
