St. Joseph's Convent

Before turning our minds back to recall a few items connected with the founding of St. Joseph's Convent, let us pause for a moment to find out the traditions of this great institution. At present the Convent is presided over by twelve nuns, well trained to teach all the requirements necessary for our young girls. The object of this school is to give moral and religious training to young ladies. A Country needs above all things young women of true christian character for wives and mothers. Higher education is a valuable asset but it must be accompanied by religious teaching. Why? Because body and soul cannot be separated in this life, that it, by training the intellect and will, we cultivate the spiritual side of nature. This is the work of the good sisters of St. Joseph's Convent.

The great benefits of St. Joseph's Convent to our Island are many, and a few I will recall. From the school many young girls are sent to bear the cross of Christ, that is, to become nuns. As a public school for girls its benefits are immeasurable as it is a source of good example and cause of much happiness in our homes. It cultivates habits of economy in young girls. There, the most cultivated arts are taught such as, painting, singing, music and education. For nearly fifty years these arts have been taught by the good sisters of St. Joseph's Convent. They have brought to many homes beauty, comfort, and happiness by the skillful productions of the pupils.

Enough has been said of the traditions and teachings of this school. Let us now recall a few facts of its foundation. In the beginning of the present century Bishop McEachern a missionary priest, ruling the destinies of the Catholic Churches in the Dioceses of Prince Edward Island and part of the mainland, made his home in St. Andrew's while there in 1803 he received a document from Monsignor Denaut, Bishop of Quebec, which advised him to build a chapel that would be convenient to the inhabitants of the Mission. In course of time a large and handsome church was built. In the year 1804 the congregation of the chapel became so numerous that a larger one had to be built. The old church was given to Bishop McEachern and arrangements were made to have it removed to Charlottetown. Towards the end of January, the Rev. Dr. McDonald so well known and loved in Charlottetown as "Father Dan", made preparations for the long and dangerous journey. On March 7th the building was within seven miles of Charlottetown, in rounding the end of Apple Tree Wharf the ice being very thin, the building became submerged and was embedded in the mud at the bottom of the river. The next day Father Dan being too fatigued to resume his place, it was taken over by Rev. Angus McDonald, Rector of St. Dunstan's. After twenty-four hours of work during the grilling rain, the old church of St. Andrew's was landed on its present site on Pownall Street. The upper story was left the full size of the building to serve as a hall, and the ferocious bovine. Suffice it to say, that the Coliseum in old Rome which was the scene of many lustily celebrated conflicts seldom in all its pristine glory beheld so Titanic a struggle.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 28.—Several hundred candidates for the Senate House of Representatives, and various State offices continued their campaigning today, the Republicans calling the attention of the electorate to prosperity and economy under the administration of President Coolidge while the Democrats were demanding tax reduction, tariff revision and farm relief legislation.

The election will be held next Tuesday when 435 members of the House of Representatives will be chosen and thirty-seven Senators in thirty-three States.

But, although the child is residing in Toronto with relatives, her parents live outside the city. Hence, the Finance Committee of the board is caught on the horns of the dilemma, between the statute requiring attendance of Nellie at school and the board's own policy of closing its doors on children whose parents or guardians are not resident of Toronto.
