That is the truth to which the revelation of God, recorded in the Bible, continually returns, as to an unshakable foundation. With the final word of that revelation, God's gift of "things" put of things, the full light of that truth was displayed.

It is most valuable to attend to what this text says and means about God. But it is possible to approach it so that the emphasis falls upon "all good things" and the mind attentive to them is led upwards till it rests in God, who is their one cause and source of being. It is the way upwards from the world to God which corresponds to the way downwards from God to the world. In their thoughts about God and the world men will always differ as to the route which helps them most and gives them most light.

There are many people who are not unbelievers who are yet more sceptical as to good things than they are as to God. They are sure that the distinction between good and evil is real and fundamental, and that it cannot be explained away, as though the good were simply the most expedient or the most useful. The pleasures which men enjoy are in themselves good; it is only in their perversion or misuse that they become bad; they are corrupted through human self-will when man is careless of the will and commandments of God, of that law which, as St. Paul declares in the opening chapters of Romans, is revealed in the order of nature.

To this goodness, in its mystery and significance, men are highly sensitive. It may be that no one capable of rational thought passes through life without, at some time being conscious of a problem and challenge. But there must be many who never stop to ask themselves why there is no problem of good, why good things, whether in nature or in man, should be assumed to be inherently reasonable, reflecting a rational constitution immanent in the world order. The problem of evil exists within a larger whole which in itself witnesses not to evil but to good. There is real point in the belief, whatever false deductions may have been made from it, that existence in itself is a deprivation, a lack of goodness and true being.

It is in the goodness of God, His righteousness and holiness, and His love, that the Christian sees the reason and cause of all other goodness. All good things point beyond themselves to God, their author and giver. And in dark days when the perverting force of evil wills rages through the world, it is well to remember the good things which abide and stand firm with no final destruction. And by that remembrance there is kept alive in the heart the desire to God the strong and lovely grace of gratitude.

Youths Emphasize Humor, Ambition And Brains In Replies To Current Survey

A magazine has been making a survey of high school boys and girls trying to find out something about their ideals of marriage, and what qualities they most desired in their mates. They discovered that more than half of the boys put a sense of humor as most important. Ambition next. Brains third. Trust fourth.

Four girls out of five wanted an ambitious husband; 54 per cent desired husbands with a sense of humor; 46 per cent were strong for brains, while only a sprinkling of the little cuties put any stress on courage in a husband.

Of course, every adolescent boy and girl in the world have a life-sized mental portrait of their future spouses, but inasmuch as it is an established fact that nobody ever marries the kind of a person they had planned to marry, these findings are of little practical value. For when it comes to the real business of picking out a life companion, there comes a time when a girl with a come-hither look in her eyes, or some lad with a way with him, and poof, away go all the fine theories about the most desired qualities in a mate.

Humor insures married happiness. It is interesting, however, to learn what the younger generation are thinking about marriage, and particularly cheering to find out that so many boys perceive the value of a sense of humor in a wife. For that is the best insurance policy a man can take out against getting a divorce, or wanting one. No wife is more desirable than the one who can laugh things off instead of turning the time her husband came home lit from a class reunion into a funny story instead of converting it into a test for a perpetual curtain lecture.

Ambition is an admirable virtue in a wife, if the man is also a go-getter who is going places, but it is a good in the side of the one who was born tired and who likes to take things sitting down. A thrifty wife is one whose price is above rubies, provided she does not pinch the pennies too hard and spoil life by asking the price of everything. HEALTH LEAGUE OF CANADA

Entitled "War Against Arthritis" an article by Dr. Wallace Graham, M. R. C. P., Toronto physician now Acting Surgeon, Lieutenant Colonel in charge of medicine at a Royal Canadian Naval Hospital, appears in the winter number of "Health" published by the Health League of Canada.

Dr. Graham points out that there are many different forms of arthritis and that the patient should not tear himself his days in a wilderness without knowing what type of arthritis he has.

Infectious arthritis, says the writer, is caused by a germ entering the blood stream and setting in the joints. It is caused either by a "strep" germ or gonorrhoeal germ joint destruction can be prevented in the early stage by treatment with sulphadiazine. Tuberculous joint disease has been reduced greatly in areas where milk is pasteurized.

Osteoarthritis occurs in older people and is due to ordinary wear and tear, causing the swelling of finger joints etc. This is not a serious disease and physiotherapy with heat and massage aid in helping the condition.

Rheumatoid arthritis, says Dr. Graham is more serious. It affects the joints of younger people and may result in loss of movement and deformity. The disease affects general health, resulting in loss of weight and weakness. The cause is still unknown. Cold has been used in recent years in treatment, with results in some cases being very successful. However, it is not looked upon as being a cure, and precautions have to be taken as it is a toxic drug and harm might result from it if not used carefully. Rest and a well-balanced, nutritious diet are essential in the treatment of such cases. Heat and massage can be used when the disease becomes quiescent to restore the function of the joints.

SPoon BREAD

2 eggs.
1 cup cornmeal.
1 1/2 teaspoon salt.
1 cup cold water.
3 cups hot milk.
2 teaspoons melted butter.

For a delicious supper dish, a change from scrambled eggs or from Welsh Rarebit, try Caracas Eggs California a much more substantial dish than the aforementioned. Shred 2 ounces dried beef quite fine. Heat 2 tablespoon butter in skillet, then crisp and brown the dried beef in the hot butter. Add to this teaspoon chili powder, 4 ounces grated cheese and one cup tomatoes. When simmering, stir in 3 beaten eggs and cook only until egg sets, like scrambled eggs. Serve hot. Sufficient for six.

Q. If a boarder does not drink tea or coffee, has the landlady the right to use his coupons for herself?
A. Boarders, whether they sleep in or out, are obliged to give their ration books to the landlady so that she may obtain the required supplies of rationed commodities. As far as ironing out the details as to whether the boarder is justified in surrendering all his butter, tea, coffee or sugar coupons—you will have to make these arrangements between yourselves as fairly as possible.

Q. What is a liaison officer?
A. Whenever there is an organized group of women—church, social or educational, the consumer branch invites them to elect one of their members to act as a liaison officer between the group and the Wartime Prices and Trade Board. This is done because all women are personally concerned in the managing of their households in war-time and are keen to understand what is being done to control prices and equalize the distribution of civilian supplies.
