There is probably somebody who is "mad," and it may be worth while to try and ascertain whether it is the editor, or his venerable "Christian" correspondent, who feels it a duty to write the above and much more in the same strain on Christmas day.

This is what every Boer sympathizer secretly or openly desires. In the meantime all such persons earn the contempt of their loyal neighbors, and are storing up for themselves many bitter and humiliating disappointments.
