Control of Opium Output is Problem of Geneva Experts

(United Press.) GENEVA, May 2.—A program which will limit effectively the production of opium and other narcotics and eventually result in the complete suppression of the drug traffic, has been prepared by Edwin Neville, the American member on the Committee of Experts of the League of Nations, and adopted by the committee to be submitted at the Opium Conference which will meet in Geneva next November.

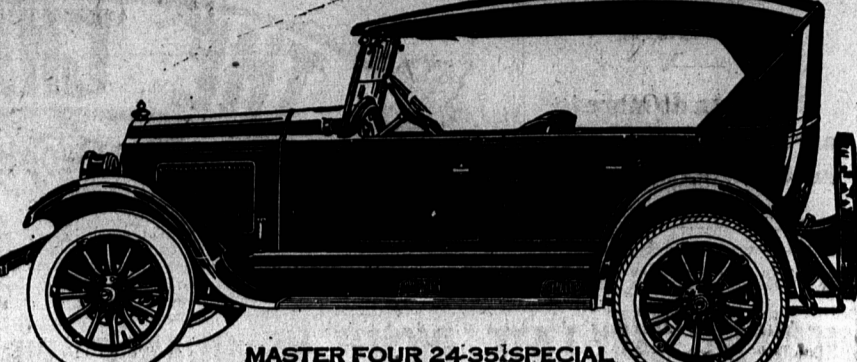
The Neville plan would restrict the production of the opium poppy and the coca leaf plant in countries where it is not known at the present time. Since the cultivation of the plants is now a large source of revenue to certain governments, it has been found impossible to effect the complete eradication of the plant at present.

It is admittedly a difficult problem, since the main source of the Persian government is reported to obtain one-third of its revenue from the production of opium. The conference will have to consider the introduction of alternative crops such as silk and cotton.

As regards transportation of the drug, Mr. Neville has accepted in principle the system of import and export licenses recently introduced by the league, which provides that the drug be exported for medicinal purposes only on a license from the importing country.

Seminoff in Exile Still Dreams of Russia Restored (United Press.) TOKIO, May 2.—Ataman Seminoff, leader of Cossacks and heir to Admiral Kolchak's illustrious title as supreme ruler of the Russias, says that "before he dies he will fight again on Russian soil" for the freedom of the Russian people.

His mission in Tokio, Seminoff told the correspondent was entirely private. He was visiting old friends and seeing to some financial interests. He called on no Japanese officials, so said, and the Japanese say they are maintaining military discipline in all its wartime rigor and effectiveness.

THE White Russians in the Orient, according to Seminoff, are in constant correspondence with the White organization in France, the leader of the extreme right in the Duma under the Czar. Greetings have been exchanged recently with the Grand Duke Nicholas, now living near Paris.

Brazil Wants To Exclude Japanese

(Canadian Press.) RIO DE JANEIRO, May 2.—Pending legislation in the United States to exclude Japanese immigration has caused widespread agitation in Brazil for similar action in this country.

Many newspapers are urging exclusion of Japanese, and the National Academy of Medicine has adopted a resolution urging amendment of the present immigration laws to restrict the Japanese quota annual to five per cent of the present Japanese population of Brazil.
