Stock Markets At A Glance

CHICAGO, June 27 — (AP) — Wheat and rye were firm to strong and the corn grains mixed in quiet futures markets today.
WINNEPEG, June 27 — (CP) — United Kingdom made further purchases of Canadian wheat on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange today taking an additional 1,000,000 bushels to bring the two-day total to 4,000,000 bushels.
TORONTO, June 27 — (CP) — Selling of cheaper gold stocks that carried prices down through several sessions, tapered off in the first hour of today's Toronto Exchange session and the market turned about and advanced through the rest of the day. At the close the group was up 38 in the index. Western Oils and Base Metals had minor gains.
MONTREAL, June 27 — (CP) — Profit-taking out down levels on stocks for utilities, industrials and papers after recent rises and golds and banks were improved in transactions today on the Stock Exchange and Curb Market. Turnover was below recent totals.
NEW YORK, June 27 — (AP) — Aviation rose fractions to more than 4 points in today's Stock Market and other selected industrials gained although the list as a whole had more minus signs than plus marks.
 Several stocks in the air group touched new highs for 1945 and under, including Boeing, Grumman, Lockheed and Pennsylvania-Central. Other yearly summits were reached by U. S. Steel, American Telephone and Caterpillar Tractor. The Associated Press 60-stock composite fell 1 of a point to 68.1 but the utility composite added 1/4 at 471-1/4 a new top since March 31, 1937.

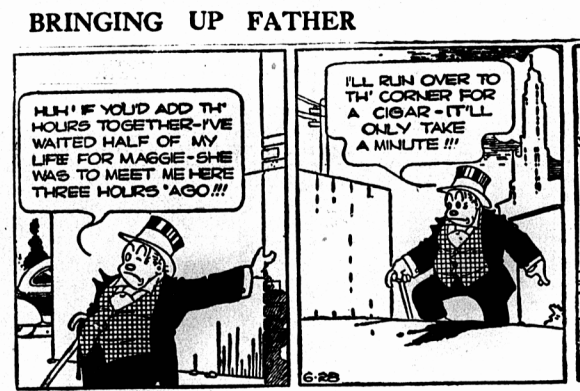
