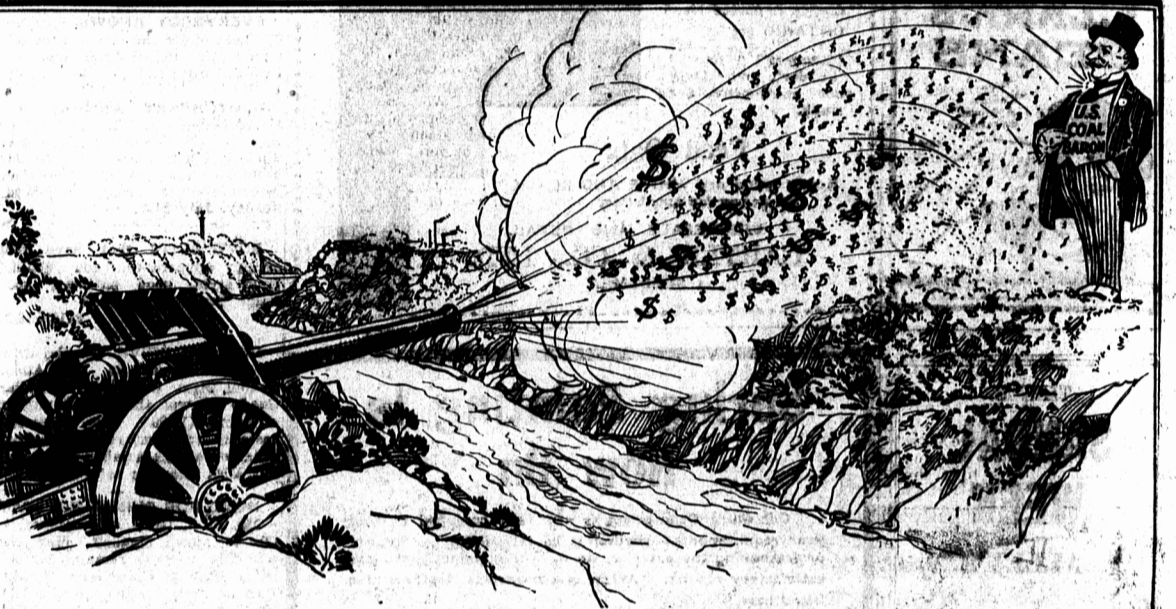

More Than a Billion Dollars - Shot

BASED upon actual thickness of seams, 1 foot and over at a depth of 4,000 feet or less, in an area of 174 square miles, the Canada Year Book 1922-23 gives the actual coal resources of Nova Scotia as over two billion metric tons with probable reserves of approximately seven billions, at greater depths.

Canada's total coal consumption in 1923 was 34,044,000 metric tons.

So if only one billion of the two billions actual, and seven billions probable, were mineable, Nova Scotia could supply all Canada at present rate of consumption with coal for the next thirty years, while she could supply Ontario and Quebec for the next half century if they used nothing but Nova Scotia coal.

And this would be only about one-tenth of the actual and probable reserves of the province, estimated by Government surveys at 9,718,000,000 tons.

Yet in thirteen years, 1912-24, Canada paid the United States coal producers and railways over one billion dollars for coal, and this rate of importation is increasing year by year.

And 95 per cent of that billion dollars went out of Ontario and Quebec, because Ontario uses Amamean coal almost exclusively,
