GOVERNOR FIRED FOR CRUELTY

BERLIN, May 8.—The Imperial district court Monday sentenced ex-Governor Horn, or the Togoland colony, to 18 months from the service because in 1913 he punished a native so severely that the man died from the effects. The native stole a cash box containing about \$200 for which he was sentenced to 12 months in a jail.

Horn confined the sentence and left the man fastened to a stake, without food and water, in the burning sun, for 24 hours. Finally, seeing that the native was on the point of collapse, Horn ordered his release.

The man's death followed.
