GLASGOW, June 5.—Women temperance workers from all parts of the globe are congregating here to attend the eighth triennial convention of the World's Woman's Christian Temperance Union, which will open its session in St Andrew's Hall next Tuesday. More than fifty countries will be represented at the big congress, which will be in session through the week. The opening of the congress will be preceded on Monday by an all-day devotional meeting, followed in the evening by a reception by the Lord Provost. Among the American delegates will be Mrs. Lillian N. M. Stevens, president of the National W. C. T. U.; Miss Eva Milbreth Foster, Miss Anna A. Gordon, Mrs. Sarah M. Hage, Mrs. Mary Sedgwick, Miss Sarah Rowell Wright, president of the Canadian W. C. T. U., and many other distinguished White Ribboners.

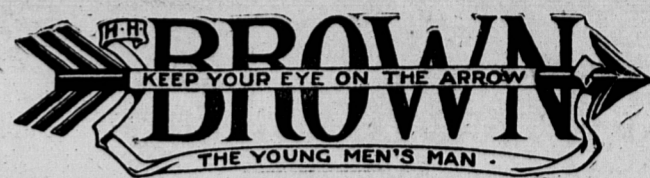
### FAVORS SOCIALISM.

BRISBANE, June 6.—Speaking at the State Labor Convention, David Bowman, M. L. A., leader of the Queensland Labor party, declared for Socialism. The object of the party, he said, is to free the people from wage slavery.

The chief industries of the state are in a prosperous condition. Immigrants are arriving by every steamer from Great Britain, and they invariably belong to the agricultural class, which it is most desirable to encourage, reflecting the care taken in selection by the government's representatives in England.

An area of 630 square miles in the Cloncurry district, known as Haslingden, was recently acquired under a lease from the lands department by a syndicate, who it is said intend to enter upon horsebreeding on a large scale. The annual rent is something like \$2,125. The land is in limestone country, and is described as most suitable for the purpose. Although nothing definite appears to be known about the proposal, it is understood that the principals have an arrangement by which it is hoped that the imperial army authorities will take a number of animals.

The minister for railways who has just returned from a tour in the Kingdom of Nandugo district states that the country is looking well. The maize crops are heavy, and it is expected that 50,000 tons of maize will be sent from those districts. The cane crop in the Isis district is also looking well.

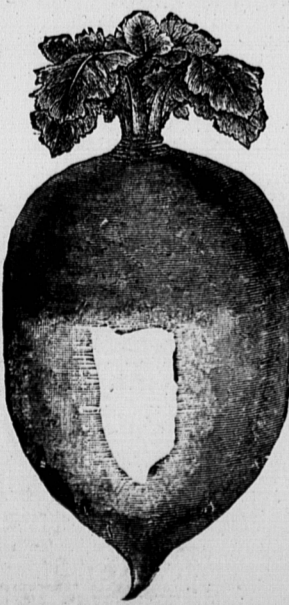

### INDIA AND THE EAST.

CALCUTTA, June 6—An appeal has been made by Hon. Raja of Kurupam for a memorial in appreciation of the services to the presidency of his excellency Sir Arthur Lawley, whose term of office expires next March.

Sir John Hewitt in summing up the debate on the united provinces budget, said the government was about to make a special examination of different heads of expenditure in order to determine whether they could be more thrifty in any direction, but he did not anticipate it would be possible to effect much economy. He was convinced of the absolute necessity of giving the local government a larger share of the revenue which accrued within the provinces in order to meet the demands for expenditure on education, particularly primary, female, and industrial education, sanitation, and medical relief.

At the annual meeting of the Bombay Millowners' Association the Hon. Mr. Fazulbhoy Currimbhoy said the future of the industry was assured, though they could not but deplore that the immediate prospects were far from satisfactory. The shortage of the United States crop and the speculative action of the "bull" operators in the States had upset all their optimistic calculations. The fact that the best managed mills in Bombay had made no loss, but had, on the other hand, shown profits even in the worst times, at once dispelled too pessimistic a view of the situation. Earnest efforts were being made to grow long-staple cotton in India, and the commodity had been much in request this year in foreign countries.
