

24 HORSES BURNED.

MONTREAL, Sept. 14.—Twenty-seven horses belonging to the Heat, Light & Power Co. were burned in a fire at the Company's stables Saturday morning. The loss is estimated at \$15,000.

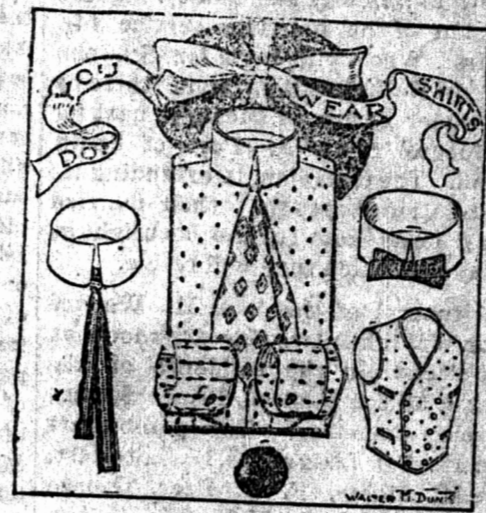
