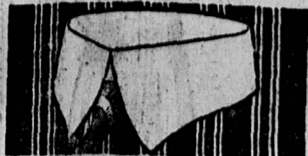

STOCKHOLM, Dec. 13.—Lenine has gone one step further. He now asks that he will refuse to recognize any distinction between Russians and Foreigners remaining in Russia after New Year's Day. The latter will consequently be subjected to the same raids on the streets and cars for immediate conscription workers in street cleaning or grave digging as the Russians nor here be granted any appeal on the grounds that they hold Holland or foreign passports.

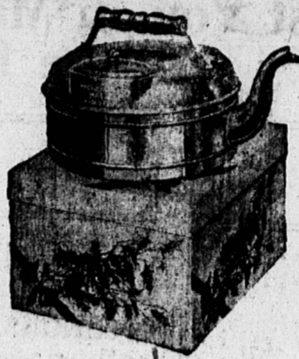
