Oxo Vegetable Dish

Soak 1/2 lb. haricot beans overnight. Fry 1/2 lb. onions in sauté-pan, with a little margarine or fat. When brown add 4 Oxo Cubes, dissolved in 1/2 pint of hot water. Grate or mince 1 carrot, add a little turmeric or paprika. Then add some hot water or milk. Simmer for one hour. Serve with toast or mashed potatoes; a little thickening added improves it.

Later he was made Bachelor of Divinity, and a Doctor of Divinity in 1902. His pastorates have been in Attwood, Ont., and St. Paul's church, Truro, now of Kentville, Ont. He is considered one of the strong men of the denomination in Canada. Rev. Dr. Macleod, is a brother of John and Andrew Macleod, Dundas, and Mrs. Herbert Jones, Harrington, P. E. I.

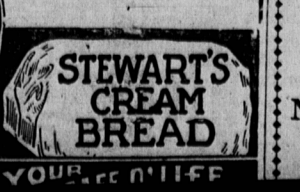
