American Art on Exhibition in London

LONDON, March 16.—An exhibition of contemporary American art at the Grafton Galleries will hold its private view tomorrow. About 200 pictures and sketches are on view, mostly of the modern, rather extremist, school.

George Bellon has a striking picture of "The Murder of Edith Cavell," showing Miss Cavell being led down a prison stair, through the midst of her sleeping guards, to her execution in the dim light of dawn. Guy Duhois is represented by a number of studies of types of the seamy side of city life and E. W. Redfield exhibits a number of landscapes mainly in winter time, which are likely to attract much attention by the admirable way in which they present New England scenery. Kent Rockwell's studies of Alaska are all the more forcible by reason of the unconventional way in which he has treated it and Theodore E. Butler's picture of Broadway by the Flat Iron Building on Victory Day carries the spectator away by its swirl of life and the brilliancy of its coloring. Robert W. Chanler is showing a number of his decorative screens, notably his "Deep Sea Fantasy" and "Peacock Competition."

The Markets

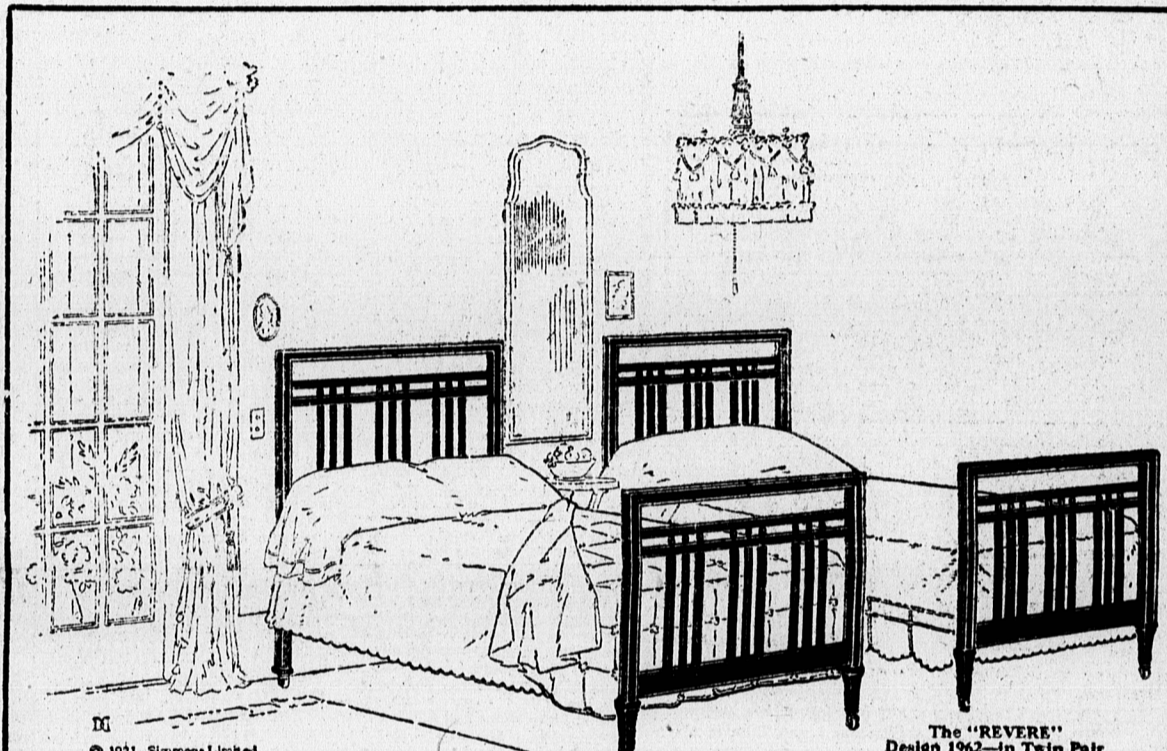
MONTREAL, March 12.—The undertone of the egg situation is weak, and the tendency of prices is towards a lower level owing to the very liberal offerings from throughout the country for shipment and the continued large supplies coming forward, which are far in excess of the daily requirements in spite of the fact that the consumption at present is heavy. The demand today was good for small lots to most immediate wants and sales were made freely at 4c to 4 1/2c per dozen, and dealers today were bidding country shippers 3 1/2c per dozen N. o. b., shipping points. The receipts today were 1,739 cases as compared with 2,359 for the same day last week, and 697 for the corresponding day a year ago.

There was no actual change in the condition of the market for dressed poultry today, prices being all lines being firmly maintained, with a good demand for supplies, and quite an active trade was done in cold storage stock for immediate consumption. We quote wholesale jobbing prices as follows: Turkeys, choice 60c to 62c Good turkeys 55c to 57c Geese 30c to 35c Chickens 40c to 42c Ducks 40c to 41c Poultry 35c to 36c The trade in potatoes continues rather quiet, but as supplies on spot are not excessive, there is no further change in prices to note. Car lots of Green Mountains being quoted at \$1 to \$1.05, and Quebec stock at 95 per bag of 90 lbs. extra, and in a wholesale jobbing way, the former sold at \$1.15, and the latter at \$1 to \$1.05 per bag of 80 lbs. extra.

Chicago, March 11.—Eggs higher. Receipts, 1,357 cases. At mark cases included 29c to 30c. New York, March 11.—Eggs unsettled. Receipts, 34,782 cases. Fresh gathered, extra firsts 31 1/2c to 34c; fresh gathered, firsts, 31 1/2c to 34c; state, Pennsylvania and nearby western, honey, whites firsts to extras, 38c to 43c; do, gathered, brown and mixed colors, firsts to extras 32c to 36c.

NOTES ON THE CHARLOTTETOWN EGG LAYING CONTEST FOR THE 19th WEEK, ENDED MARCH 13, 1921

The Charlottetown Egg Laying Contest made almost as great gains in the 19th week as in the previous one. The total number of eggs laid was 779, or 210 more than in the previous week. There are 10 hens in each pen, a total of 250 birds, and with 199 laying, we received eggs from about 80 per cent of all the birds. There are still 29 hens that have not laid since the contest started. Six birds laid a possible of 7 eggs each during the week, 19 birds laid 6 eggs, 53 birds laid 5 eggs, 43 birds laid 4 eggs, 52 birds laid 3 eggs, 24 birds laid 2 eggs, 17 birds laid 1 egg, and 51 birds did not lay during the week. The White Leghorns secured first place for the week; the pen of Mrs. R. W. Bullpitt of Cardigan tied with the Experimental Farm's pen No. 21. For first place, with 50 eggs each. The pen of Barred Rocks No. 23, owned by the Experimental Station tied with the pen of White Leghorns owned by William
