

Trading was slow to start and at the time of writing there were only a few sales made at prices steady with last week's closing. Buyers were bidding on all classes of cattle at prices steady to lower than last week.
Calf receipts 933, with a light run the calf market was very brisk. Veal calves moved at prices steady with last week's closing at a price range of 12 to 15 with an odd sale at 15.50. Drinkers or paif fed calves were 25 cents to 50 cents higher with the quality offered bringing from 8 to 11. There were only a few grassers which were weighed up from 7 to 9.
Hog receipts 401, with a very light run salesmen are asking higher prices with the buyers bidding steady with last week's closing at a price range of 12 to 15 with an odd sale at 15.50. Drinkers or paif fed calves were 25 cents to 50 cents higher with the quality offered bringing from 8 to 11. There were only a few grassers which were weighed up from 7 to 9.
Sheep receipts 603, lambs steady with lots moving to the scale at a price of 18 to 16.50 for good quality with light common lambs bringing as low as 11. Early sales of sheep were made at steady prices of 5 to 8.50.
