### EMPEROR AND AUTOCRAT.

In ancient mythology 'Jove, who forged the chain of fate was ever after forced to wear it.' Something comparable to this is the case of the Autocrat of all the Russias. He called the new Parliament or Douma into existence and that body by sweeping majority has resolved that the Czar is no longer an Autocrat. The Imperial rulers of Russia have held that title long but the Douma affirms it to be inconsistent with the new constitution which gives Russia a Parliament. This has angered the Czar who still holds himself superior to the constitution. He resents any limitation of his powers, and that in no uncertain terms. The chain calls him, but it is a very strong chain, as he will yet find.

Premier Stolypin, who speaks for the Czar, replied to the Douma: "The pernicious agitation originated by the Revolution has degenerated into open brigandage. Criminals have come to the foreground in a movement by which the industries of the country are being ruined and the younger generation demoralized. Any weakness in handling this situation would be a crime, and the Government, in the future as in the past, will continue to crush disorders with an iron hand and insist upon loyal service from all state officials. The personal political opinion of these officials will not be allowed to interfere with the Government's course."

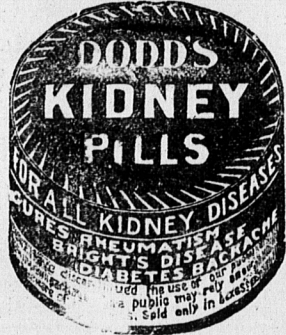
The Czar is badly advised; the autocracy must go—has already gone, if he could but realize it. But the influences of the grand ducal ring and all the reactionary forces of the state and the church are behind this deliverance of Premier Stolypin. Something like a dead-lock is now on and it may result in the third Douma being sent into oblivion along with the first and second Donnas. But then another Parliament must be called and the conflict between the autocracy and the representative body will be irrepressible till the latter shall win.

### AGAINST THE CIGARETTE.

A large delegation of ladies representing several Provinces waited upon the Government on Tuesday last asking for more stringent legislation against the use of cigarette. They were graciously received by Sir Wilfrid Laurier and Hon. Messrs Scott and Graham. The Premier does not use tobacco in any form; Mr. Scott uses neither tobacco nor liquor; Mr. Graham is an abstainer from wines and liquors, but as to tobacco "he was not so sure."

The ladies pointed out that Parliament has already passed a resolution against the manufacture, importation and sale of cigarettes but the influence of the Tobacco Trust had prevented the necessary legislation to give effect to this resolve. In view of the difficulty of legislating on the matter for the entire Dominion the ladies suggested giving power to each Province, or to each municipality, to deal with the cigarette evil as the Scott Act deals with intoxicants. This proposition, Mr. Graham said would be looked into.

It seems improbable that any present action will be taken by Parliament to limit the manufacture or importation of cigarettes although the use of them by youths is generally admitted to be injurious, and there are many who believe the use of tobacco in any form is injurious to persons of all ages. The sale to youths



under eighteen years has been in many places forbidden under penalty, but remarkably this has not proved much more effective than our curfew bye-laws.

Sir Frederick Borden has obtained an apology from the Nineteenth Century Magazine for quoting against him the scandalous aspersions of an obscure Calgary sheet. The Nineteenth Century did well to apologise. None the less Sir Frederick's position whether in the Government, in Parliament or in the country is not a strong one.

In regard to the new trade treaty with France it seems remarkable that our exports to that country for the nine months ended with March last were but \$1,400,572, while to Belgium we exported a value of \$1,837,958. Imports from France during the same period were \$6,660,412 and from Belgium only \$1,665,179. The value of the new treaty will depend largely upon how far it may afford a paying market for Canadian products.

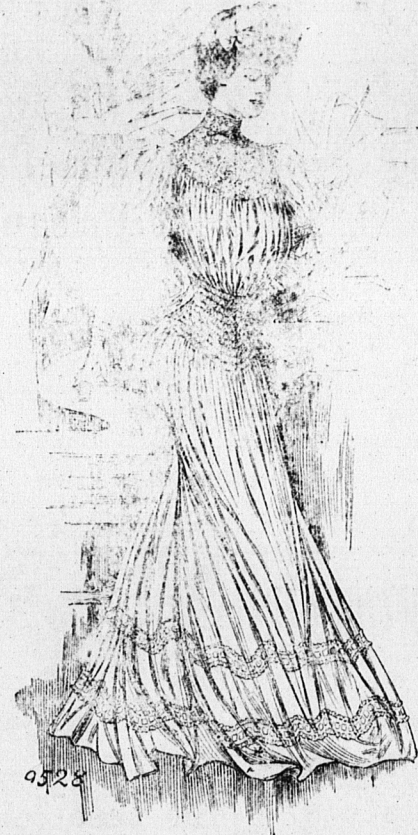
