**Good Time Is Picked Harness Horse Of Year**

NEW YORK, Dec. 11.—(AP)—Good Time, three-year-old pacing star owned by William H. Cane of Goshen, N.Y., was named harness horse of the year Saturday.

The bay son of Hal Dale-On Time is the first pacer and the first three-year-old to win the award, sponsored by the Trotting Horse Club of America.

Good Time won the Little Brown Jug, Matron Stakes, Review Futurity and Western Pace. He lost one race in nine starts, and earned \$58,795. Good Time's total earnings are \$105,198, most money ever

won by a harness horse—trotter or pacer—as a two- and three-year-old.

Fifth in the 1948 poll, when he was a standout juvenile, Good Time rolled up 421 points this year in a poll of turf writers, sports editors, and sports broadcasters in the United States. Good Time, driven in all his races by Frank Ervin of Aiken, S.C., set a world record for two heats over a mile track, with times of 2:01 3/5 and 1:59 3/5.

Second place in the poll went to Proximity, aged trotting mare owned by the Verhurst Brothers, Victor, N.Y., with 265 points.

Rodney, giant trotting stallion which won the award last year, was third with 186 points. Rodney is owned by the estate of R. Horace Johnston, Charlotte, N.C.


