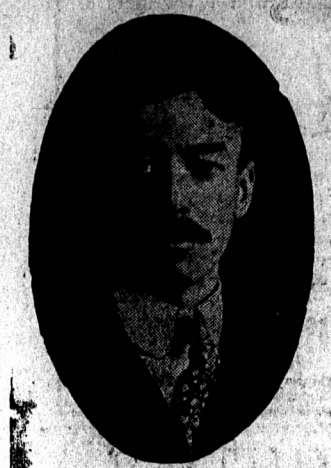

EUROPEAN NEWS

BERLIN, Oct. 26. (Special)—Berlin is suffering from the gambling craze. Hardly a week has passed this summer without bringing the announcement of some gambling scandal; suicides, flights, and disgrace have been the more usual consequence of the epidemic, which is greater in the German capital at the present time than in any other city.

In August two leading Berlin lawyers who gambled heavily disappeared. One was found dead in the Seine near Paris, and letters in his pocket showed that he had ruined himself by high play. The other fugitive has not been traced.

One hears constantly of business men, merchants, and actors who have gone bankrupt, and officers who have been forced to resign from the army, owing to the fact that they had become involved in "debts of honor."

The increase in gambling is owing to the fact that many Germans have made great fortunes rapidly, and have become addicted to luxurious living. Within the past quarter of a century Berlin had become a luxurious capital, and as it is unable to rival Paris and London in beauty and charm, it tries to outdo them in extravagance and ostentation.

A great money-spending wave has swept over the empire, and the old, frugal "Molke spirit," to which it is alleged Germany owes her greatness, is now considered an antiquated legend, unworthy of the present-day standard of living.

ODESSA, Oct. 30 (Special)—The "Golos Moskvi," in an article headed "What is Happening on the Amur Railway," publishes a brief but terrific account of the treatment of the convict laborers on the new Amur Railway. There are no fewer than 17,000 convicts, including a considerable number of "political criminals," employed on the constructive work of the line.

Some two years ago the chief inspector of the convict gangs, a Russian named Savitzki, was removed from his post for gross cruelty to the convicts. In his place was appointed a certain Leonovitch, who was instructed by the Crown Attorney at Tshita to adopt milder disciplinary methods. It is these "milder methods" that the Moscow journal now describes.

ST. PETERSBURG, Oct. 26—(Special)—The first Finn arrested for refusing to obey the new Russian law of rights for Russia in Finland has been brought to St. Petersburg in triumph. This is the first time the Russians have executed their own justice on Finnish soil, and the incident is regarded as little short of sacrilege by the Finnish Separatists.

LONDON, Oct. 30 (Special)—Another circular is shortly to be sent out from the War Office laying down how much an officer is to spend each month. In the past these efforts have only led to wholesale resignations, and it is still believed in the Service that the real reason for a certain peer resigning his commission was because of an official complaint respecting the money that he chose to spend upon his stud of polo ponies.

LONDON, Oct. 30 (Special)—A National Society of Free Workers has been formed to resist trade union intimidation, and it is hoped to organize non-union workers, so that a minority of trade unionists shall not be able to force a strike, and non-union men who do not join a strike shall have protection if required. It is also proposed to agitate for legislation to limit the number of pickets to be employed in industrial disputes.

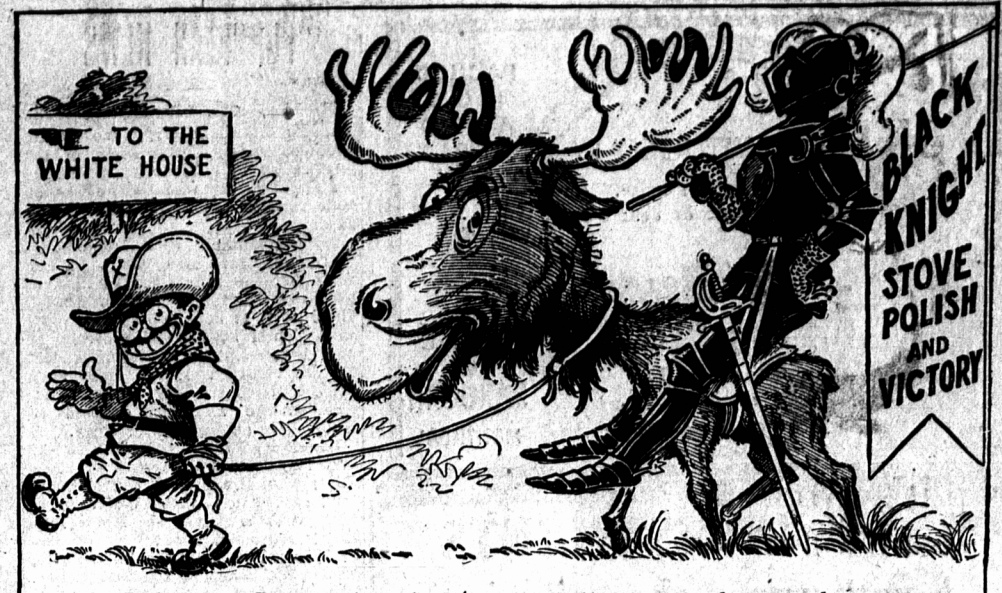

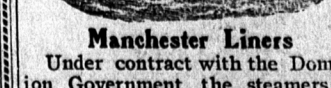
