Butter Prices

The price of butter in Charlottetown retail stores dropped two cents Monday in compliance with a recent order of the Wartime Prices and Trade Board. A check on prices in the principal stores yesterday revealed that butter is selling at 41 cents per pound as against 43 cents a few days ago.

One large retail firm in the city was charging only 40 cts. while another was one-cent above the majority charge of 41 cents. Mr. G. Harbour, Prices and Supply Representative of the Wartime Prices Board pointed out that the two-cent reduction across Canada brought the price back to the level of the basic period. However, in the Maritime Provinces retailers and jobbers were allowed one-half a cent for their butter.
