FRENCH CANADIAN'S BEAT RENFREWS

MONTREAL, Jan. 15—About five hundred spectators on Saturday saw the French Canadian team easily dispose of Renfrew at the Arena, the closing score being four goals to one. Although Renfrew opened the scoring with a poor shot which only just beat Veziha, they were for the remainder of the game boxed up by the speed of the Canadians who played well up to championship form. On Saturday's play the victors should easily account for the Wanderers when they meet on Wednesday. The winners gave a brilliant exhibition of hockey being particularly strong in defence play. Renfrew's only goal was registered by Smith, three minutes from the commencement of play. Inside two minutes Payan equalized and Lalonde put on two more points during the second period. Dallaire scored for the Canadians in the final period. Towards the close of play Taylor showed to advantage, but he was unable to get away from the fast French players.

GEORGIAN BAY CANAL FIRST STEPS TAKEN.

OTTAWA, Jan 17—The fact that \$3,000,000 is included in the supplementary estimates for deepening the Back River at Montreal, Riviere Des Prairies and French River, is taken to indicate that the Government has at length decided to go ahead with the Georgian Bay Canal. The works mentioned are on the proposed route on the canal.

ENGLAND'S AGED PEERS

Lord Strathcona, who celebrated his 90th birthday recently by working all day at his desk in his office as High Commissioner for Canada, is not the grand old man of the peerage despite his robust age. The Earl of Wemyss is older and is as spry at 94 as Lord Strathcona is at 90. Lord Wemyss—he pronounces his name as if spelled Eeems—holds another record, he has been a member of the House of Commons and of the House of Lords uninterruptedly for more than 69 years.

The peerage, like the poorhouse, seems conducive to old age. Lord Gwydyr died last year at the fine old age of 98. There are fourteen peers besides Lord Strathcona and Lord Wemyss who were alive when George IV. was on the throne, and George IV. died in 1838. They are Lord Nelson, Lord Cross, Lord Sydney, Lord Kintford, Lord Halsbury, Lord Abergavenny, Lord Lisburne, Lord Ashcombe, Lord James of Hereford, Lord Lindley, Lord Mount Stephen, Lord Peel, Lord Stanmore and Lord Feversham.

Contrasted with the great age of these members of the House of Lords is the comparative youth of nearly all the sovereigns of Europe. George V. is a comparatively young man. His cousin, the King of Norway and the Czar of Russia, are also young, while another cousin, the German Kaiser, is still in the prime of life, having barely turned 50.

The King of Spain and the King of Portugal are mere boys, while the Queen of Holland is only 30. The Emperor, Francis Joseph, of Austria, is the oldest sovereign in Europe and celebrated his 80th birthday on August 18th. He is in sound health and bids fair to live many more years.

ROYALTY WILL TESTIFY IN THIS CASE

COPENHAGEN, Jan. 14—The Dowager Queen Sophia, of Sweden, and Queen Louise of Denmark, are among the members of royalty summoned to give testimony in the famous de la Brach case, which came up in court here today for trial. For many years the case has been a staple of both in Copenhagen, and in Stockholm, and the public in both cities is on edge in anticipation of a revelation of the mystery which is said to involve the royal families of Sweden and Denmark.

The central figure in the mystery is Helga de la Brach, who died some twenty-five years ago, leaving a will in which she claimed to be the daughter of King Gustavus IV. of Sweden and his consort, Princess Fredrika of Baden. The suit is brought by relatives of the woman to establish her claims to a part of the fortune in possession of the Swedish royal family. The royal house of Denmark is involved through the fact that Queen Louise was a Swedish princess before her marriage.

Many persons are of the opinion that the claims of Miss de la Brach were not without foundation. Certain it is that she enjoyed a state subvention for many years, was admitted to the highest circles of society in Stockholm, where she was usually referred to as "princess," and was frequently seen in the company of royalties.

For the most part, however, her life was shrouded in deep mystery. As a child she was educated abroad with funds provided from an unknown source. When she came of age she returned to Sweden and continued to live in a state of luxury. A few years before her death, however, her fortune failed, and she died in apparent poverty.


