CHURCH DEBT ABOUT WIPED OUT.

MONTREAL, July 9.—It is announced that the floating debt of the St. James Methodist church, this city, which amounted to \$170,000 has been reduced to \$3,500 and it is expected that this will be paid off within a few days. The blanket mortgage on the church of \$4,500 has been cut down to \$550, and it is expected that the congregation will be able to pay this off within a few days. The Methodist churches throughout Canada contributed to the removal of the debt.
