One of the most interesting chapters in medicine is the discovery of the cure of diphtheria. Since the time of Napoleon, patient investigators were at work, but not till the closing years of the last century were their efforts crowned with success.

Napoleon had a favorite nephew who died of diphtheria and in his will he set aside a sum of money to remain at interest and to be given as a reward to the discoverer of a cure for this fell destroyer of young children.

and the work of the immortal Pasteur in his study of the life history of germs are fundamental steps in this great discovery.

What furnished the key to the discovery was a reflection on the reason why one does not take scarlet fever, smallpox, measles or whooping cough the second time. The answer is obvious; that each of these diseases leaves something behind; a distinct product of the disease, that makes a permanent change in the system.

A prolonged series of experiments was made with the germs of diphtheria upon animals. The horse was found to possess a very great resistance against the poison and he was given dose after dose of it by subcutaneous injection till he withstood enormous doses. He was then considered to be immune from diphtheria, that is, he was so full of the by-products of diphtheria germs that the germs could no longer live in his system.

The discovery of anti-toxine is one of the greatest epochs in the history of medicine in the nineteenth century and there is a hope that many, if not all the diseases that human flesh is heir to will be cured in a similar manner.

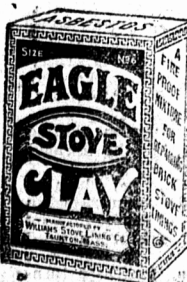
