BOY DROWNED IN AMHERST

AMHERST, Aug. 3.-For the third time in the past five years Blair's lake, a sheet of water about two miles from Amherst, was the scene of a drowning accident.

To-day a large crowd of young men from Amherst walked out to the lake to enjoy a dip. They swam and splashed around in the water for the best part of an hour. The greater part of the bunch then went ashore and commenced dressing. Frank Sweeney swam around in the water for a short time longer when suddenly he sank from sight.

He arose to the surface a few seconds later and then went down like a log. A young man by the name of Logan was in the water at the time, but could not render any assistance as the water was too deep, and he could not swim. Grappling irons were soon secured and after dragging in the vicinity for about three-quarters of an hour the body was brought to the surface. Doctors McDougall and Hawboldt, who had been summoned shortly after the man went down, worked over the body for some time, but all to no avail. Life was extinct. Dr. Hawboldt afterwards said that the man died from heart failure and was probably dead when he came to the surface the second time.

The deceased was a nephew of Hon. Frank Sweeney, of Moncton, and of P. G. Mahoney, M. P. for Westmoreland. He belonged to Melrose.
