GLACE BAY, N. S., June 20 — (CP) — Canadian middleweight champion George Ross of West Bay Road, N. S., stretched his undefeated string as a professional to 37 by jabbing out a split decision over Joe Pyle of New Waterford, N. S., in a 10-round non-title bout here tonight. There were no knock-downs.

More than 4,500 fans saw Ross, carrying a five-pound weight advantage at 152, score heavily in the infighting and keep away from Pyle's knockout punches to earn the nod from the two judges.

Youth Vs. Age In Heavyweight Title Bout

CHICAGO, June 20, — (AP) — Youth vs. Experience sums up Wednesday night's scrap between Ezzard Charles of Cincinnati and Jersey Joe Walcott of Camden, N. J., for the National Boxing Association version of the world heavyweight championship.

Can 27-year-old Charles, giving away some 15 pounds, catch the wily will of the wisp who made Joe Louis miss for 25 rounds?

After a year's layoff, will the legs of 35-year-old Jersey Joe be able to stand another long pursuit race?

Will Walcott manoeuvre Charles into openings for the sneak rights that floored Louis three times?

If he is dropped early, will youth help Charles get off the floor to win in the late rounds?

These are just a few of the questions puzzling the oddsmakers who made Charles an early 5-to-7 favorite. There are indications it might come down to 6 to 5 pick 'em by ring time.

During Walcott's long training grind that ended yesterday, there was no indication that he suffered from the year's "vacation."

Charles, who finished boxing today, professed to be unworried about the extra poundage.

"I fought big fellows before," he said. "Joe Baksi weighed around 210 1-2 and Joe Haynes 214 and I knocked out both of them."

Doubleheader At C. and B. Diamond Wednesday Afternoon

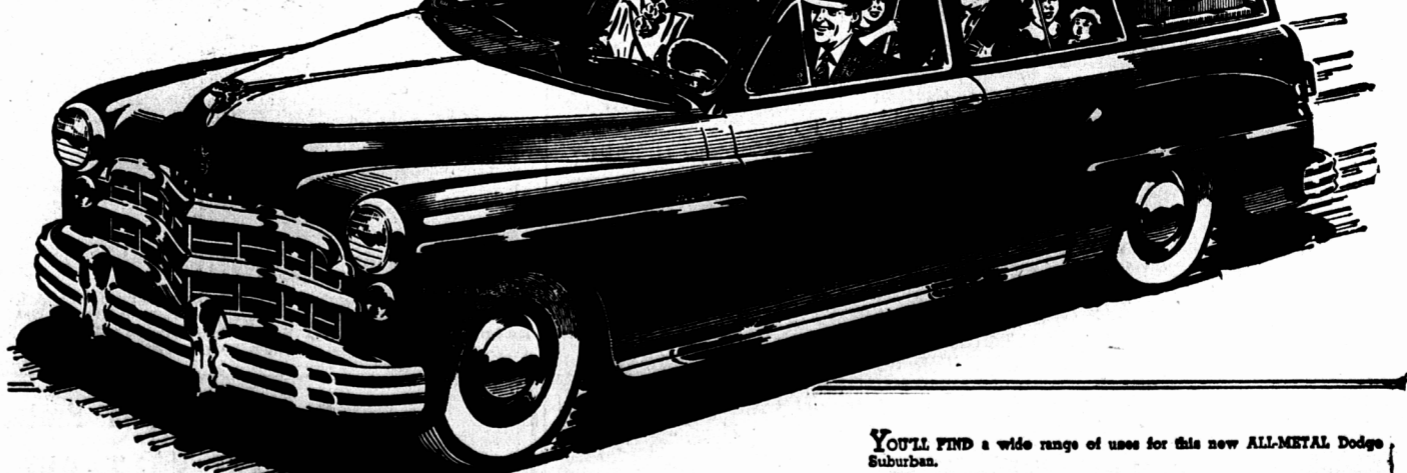
