MONEY IN BASEBALL.

NEW YORK, August 13—Men present here, declare that the prominent in big league baseball campaign will be a lean one for several of the major clubs, although none of them are likely actually to lose money. The box money makers will be as usual, the New York Nationals, Boston Red Sox, both Chicago clubs, the Pittsburgh, Washingtons and Athletics. It is estimated that the Giants will yield nearly \$250,000 in profits. The Boston Red Sox have done a phenomenal business at home and abroad, and expects to show the net profit of \$200,000. Estimates on some of the other clubs are as follows:

Chicago Americans \$175,000; Chicago Nationals \$150,000; Pittsburgh \$100,000; Washington, \$100,000; Brooklyn \$50,000.

NEW POSTAL FRAUD.

OTTAWA, August 13—A perfectly new and original postal fraud had resulted in the issue of a notice of warning to postmasters by the post office department. The officers of the department somehow discovered that a package of third class matter sent from Toronto was received by the addressee who opened the parcel, took out what he wanted of the contents and then returned the balance in the original wrapper without postage. The department points out that this is an illegal practice and postmasters are required to see that only unopened packages are returned to senders free.

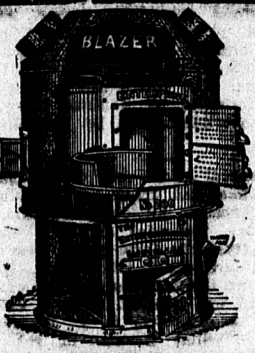
