Business optimism was still predominant in Wall Street and offerings were comparatively light throughout. The urge for profits, though apparently was too much for some traders and these decided to begin lightening commitments.

Metals generally were firmer, although nickel slipped 1-2 to 55-34 though at the close. Ahead narrowly were Smelters, Hudson Bay and Noranda.

Off slightly were St. Lawrence Corp., St. Lawrence Paper preferred and Dominion Bridge.
