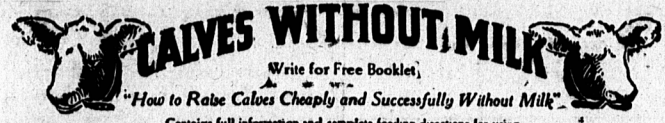

HOUSEHOLD NOTES.

Keep an onion planted in a flower pot. When a little seasoning is needed, clip from the young shoots. The shoots can be cut fine and used in a salad.

If a china cabinet has no grooves in which to stand plates upright, it is a good plan to use glass-headed tacks. They will answer as well and will not injure the shell.

To cut citron easily, place it in a bowl, pour boiling water over it, and allow it to remain for a few minutes. One can cut or shave it almost as easily as one can cut raisins or soft fruits.

When the candle is too large to put in the candlestick, dip the end in hot water for a few moments to melt down to the required size.

Moths can be successfully removed from carpets by a simple method. Wring a course towel out of clear water and spread it smoothly on the carpet. Press with a good hot iron, repeating the operation wherever the moths are. There is no need to press hard, and the color of the carpet will not be injured. The moths are destroyed by the heat and steam.

To let air into the sleeping room in winter, it is a good plan to tack muslin on a removable screen and place in the window, as there can be no draft or snow admitted. It can be removed in the daytime.

Old potatoes are apt to turn to a dark color in the boiling. The way to prevent this is to add a tablespoonful of sweet milk to the water in which you boil them. You will find them nice and white when done.

To clean granite ware of smoke and discoloration, wet an old cloth with kerosene and wipe the smoke away. It is surprising how easily this will remove the grim, and if the utensils are then immersed in hot soapy water and rinsed they will not require such an amount of scrubbing.

When the old flannel garments are being patched, old flannel should be used, but if there is none of this at hand the new flannel should be well washed and shrunk before it is joined to the old, otherwise the mended part will soon be out of proportion and will not fit properly into the garment.

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH WEST LAND REGULATIONS.
 ANY person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.
 Duties.—Six months residence upon cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.
 In certain districts a homesteader in section alongside his homestead. Price \$20.00 per acre.
 Duties.—Must reside upon the homestead or pre-empt six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to clear homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extra.
 A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain pre-emption in certain districts. Price \$20.00 per acre. Duties.—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$20.00.
