**Smallwood Has Plans For Sheep Raising, Fisheries**

ST. JOHN'S, Nfld., Jan. 3 (CP) — Fishing has long been a common denominator between Newfoundlanders and Icelanders but now sheep raising has slipped into the act.

Premier Smallwood created a bit of a stir here when he announced at New Year's that Icelandic fishermen had been imported to teach modern methods of fishing. He also announced that the Government is investigating the possibilities of sheep-raising here along the lines in vogue in Iceland.

Mr. Smallwood said an official is going to Iceland soon to "see what they're doing over there. Iceland is a big sheep-raising country, and if they can do it away up there, and make it pay, why can't we here in Newfoundland?"

In the matter of Newfoundland-Iceland fishing, the Premier went into detail. The government is backing financially a venture by which two Icelanders — with four vessels — came to Newfoundland recently to teach modern methods of fishing.

"Later I expect to see some girls come out from Iceland to teach the very fine Iceland system of curing herring," Mr. Smallwood said. It would not be long before a "big fish manufacturer" established a modern fish processing and fish-packing plant here.

"These Icelanders tell me they are convinced that here in our Newfoundland waters we have the biggest herring resources in the whole world but they laugh at the idea of trying to catch a few by gill nets after the herring get into the bays and arms along the coast.

"In Iceland they have 200 vessels from 50 to 500 tons catching herring in deep water, and an-
