

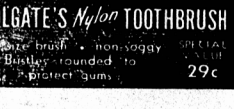

LONDON, Jan. 30 — (CP) — People call King George of Greece the loneliest man in London. He has always kept himself aloof, appearing only infrequently on state occasions since his arrival after a hurried flight from Crete in a one-time Royal Navy destroyer which now is H.M.C.S. Kootenay.

The king's only apparent relaxation is taking long walks in the London he knows and loves. He almost invariably walks alone. It is a time for him to get away from the noise and bustle of the city.
