CANADIAN DISCHARGED IN BRITAIN PROTEST AGAINST LOSS IN EXCHANGE

LONDON, Nov. 30.—Letters continue to pour into the Canadian Pay Office from Canadian officers and soldiers discharged in Britain, protesting against the loss in the exchange rate on pensions and gratuities. As previously explained, the Dominion Government is paying at par, which means a net loss of 12 per cent to 20,000 Canadian soldiers now in Britain and a total gain estimated at about \$700,000 to the Government.

An instance of the unsatisfactory working out of reciprocity in the treatment of disabled soldiers, as between Canada and Britain, which was pointed out some time ago, has been referred by the G. W. V. A. to the Department of Soldiers' Civil Re-establishment. It is the case of Acting-Adj. Bowden who was recommended by the Canadian Board of Pensions ten weeks ago for surgical fittings which would enable him to walk without pain from his disabilities, but after being sent from pillar to post, he has not received them, and does not expect them this year.

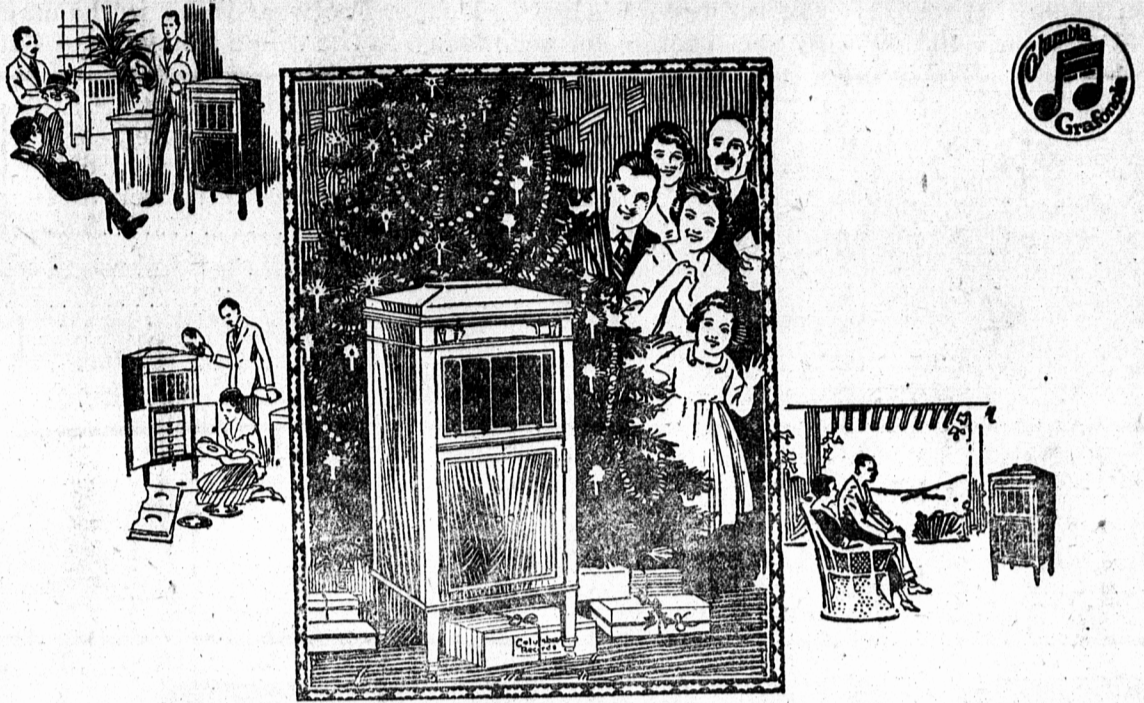

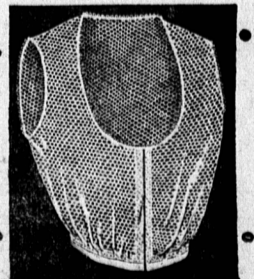
