HOTEL CLERK, BEAUTIFUL HEIRESS; FORGERY



ST. LOUIS, Mo., Aug. 1.—Dwight Fortner is coming back to St. Louis from Europe in handcuffs to stand trial for a \$11,000 forgery.

Fortner was a hotel clerk when he won the heart of beautiful Katherine Handlin, heiress to a million, member of one of the proud old St. Louis families who count back to Tidewater Virginia.

Miss Handlin was a guest at the Jefferson hotel, Fortner a clerk there, when they first met. There was the usual family row when the proud Handlins learned of Katherine's infatuation, but she could see no one else than the good-looking clerk.

So they were married, regardless, and were very happy. Fortner left the hotel and branched out as a real estate operator.

All went well until— Well, Fortner, it is charged, cashed a draft for \$12,000 at the St. Louis Trust Co., left goodbyes and \$1000 of it with his stenographer to give to his beautiful young wife and disappeared.

While Fortner went to New Orleans, then traveled through Panama, discovery was made that the check he had cashed had been forged. H. C. Tully, wealthy operator, was the victim. Other forgeries turned up, amounting to \$30,000. They were all charged to the former hotel clerk. Police got busy. In the meantime Fortner sailed for Paris. There he led the life of the gay American millionaire. Money was spent like water. Braving recognition by St. Louis people, Fortner went everywhere—on the Bourse, in the Latin quarter, at the opera, the museums, the races.

Arrests were made, but the ex-hotel clerk defied extradition and went on his merry way. One set of papers were set aside as improperly drawn. But in the end the laws were tightened and the French government announced that it would send Fortner back to St. Louis to stand trial. In this extremity, while Fortner is on his way back a prisoner, only his wife, the beautiful Katherine Handlin, who learned to love him when he was a poor clerk, is still loyal.
