BULLER

Confesses Advising White to Surrender.

A BIG STORM AROUSED

Hostile Press Criticisms—Buller May Resign—Can't Be a Lord.

GENERAL BULLER'S CONFESSION. LONDON, Oct. 11.—(Special).—Speaking after a luncheon in his honor General Buller caused a great sensation by telling that after the failure of his attack at Colenso he telegraphed General White advising the surrender of Ladysmith.

IT CAUSES STORM OF CENSURE. The speech has caused a storm that may cause Buller's resignation, for the papers all declare the surrender of Ladysmith would have been a humiliation compared with which all other reverses of the war have been trivial.

It is believed the speech will kill the intended elevation of General Buller to the Peerage at the next list of honors.
