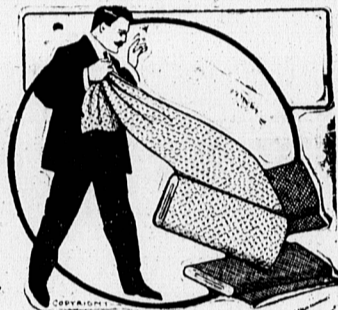

## EXPLORER GRINFELL HAS TAKEN BRIDE

CHICAGO, Ill, Nov 21—Dr. Wilfred T. Greenfell, the hero of the Labrador Coast was married here on Thursday evening to Miss Annie E. MacClanahan, daughter of Mrs. Edmund Buke MacClanahan in Grace Episcopal Church. Dr. Greenfell first met his bride during a trip from England last spring. The young lady is a graduate of Vassar, and has been actively engaged in sociological work in Chicago. After a honeymoon trip which will be attended by a series of lectures by the doctor they will return to Newfoundland by the end of the year and proceed to St. Anthony.

## IT'S COSTLY AS WELL AS A NUISANCE

CINCINNATI, Nov 21—The economic aspect of the smoke nuisance was the subject of an address before the convention of the American Civic Association by Herbert M. Wilson, chief engineer in the United States, geological survey.

Mr. Wilson summed up the annual toll levied by smoke damage and waste in the United States saying that a conservative estimate would be \$600,000,000 in the large cities alone.

In more detail he said: The smoke nuisance is one of the greatest dangers of modern times, insidiously attacking the health of the individual, lowering his vitality, increasing the death rate, and causing untold loss and injury to property.

"Our present method of burning coal with smoke is costing the people of this country unnecessarily \$90,000,000, because of imperfect combustion. It is estimated that eight per cent of the coal used in the production of power, light and heat, or in all about twelfth million tons of coal, is going up the chimneys each year in smoke. This coal costs the people at least \$40,000,000. It is further estimated that in the production of coke twenty-five million tons of coal are wasted in the air. The coal is worth \$50,000,000.

"Altogether, the situation is hopeful. The smokeless city in the future is to be the note of civilization; a smoky city is to be the sign of barbarism, and not the badge of prosperity some have boasted it."

## PROTESTED AGAINST CONGO ATROCITIES

LONDON, Nov 21—A remarkable meeting at a protest against oppression and cruelty in the Congo was held at Albert Hall last night. The Archbishop of Canterbury presided, and every branch of religious unity was represented. Among those in the audience were numerous bishops, forty members of the House of Commons, and several peers. Sir Arthur Conan Doyle, Edmund D. Morel, Honorable Secretary of the Congo Reform Association, and a host of ministers of all denominations.

## CREW OFF STEAMER IN BAD WAY

LOS ANGELES, Nov 22—Famished, nearly exhausted and clad in borrowed clothes, 105 men, women, and children passengers on the steamer St. Croix, which was burned and sank off Point Duma, have arrived here. With them came 78 members of the crew, likewise exhausted and destitute.
