RUSTY BLACKBIRD

Being so well acquainted with the Crow, you know that not all black birds are Blackbirds. You may not, however, be aware that Blackbirds are not always black. The Rusty Blackbird is a good example of this. True enough, in spring Mr. Rusty is really black, lacking somewhat the iridescence of the Grackle. But at that time his wife is slate-grey; and now, in the autumn, every member of the family, mother, father, and children, have earned the name "Rusty." Their caps are red, bordered by a light eyebrow line; many feathers are rusty-tipped; and underparts are closely barred.

Rusty Blackbirds can be seen in large numbers. Then they pass through, often in huge flocks of mixed Blackbirds, but may be identified when close at hand by their pale yellow eyes. Grackles are the only others with similar eyes, but their considerably larger size and long, keel-like tails prevent us from confusing them with the rest of the Blackbirds. The average length of a Rusty is 9 inches, the size of a small Robin. The male Redwing's bright epaulettes are distinctive; the female reminds us of a large Sparrow, heavily striped. The Cowbird averages only 7 1/2 inches, and has a very much shorter bill.

Rusty Blackbirds must be heard, because the snow is sometimes still lying on the ground when they are moving north in spring, and they are in the last Blackbird "HILLS" HIDE BURIED GOLD.
