CAVE WAS FULL OF DEAD MONKS

Remarkable Discoveries by a German Explorer

BERLIN, Feb. 4.—Dr. von LeCoq has made some remarkable discoveries in the Taurus mountains, where he was sent on behalf of the German government to make excavations. The expeditions, after digging for three months at the buried City of Dabkanis, near Karakobe, between Turan and Lukhnu, secured a great quantity of manuscripts. They lay hidden in caves filled with mud. They were on Chinese paper, white leather, or wood. Numerous wall paintings were discovered, some on plaster with a background of gold leaf, others on mud. These paintings are Buddhist.
