Germany Boosts Tobacco Trades

BERLIN, Oct. 6.—(C.P.)—A tobacco cartel is to be formed by the largest processors in Germany with a view to putting the industry on a sounder basis, encouraging the production of tobacco in the Reich and also to placing foreign tobacco orders with countries offering markets for German exports.

Under the projected cartel's terms Hamburg and Dresden would be picked for huge tobacco processing plants from which the major German tobacco firms would agree to buy one-fourth of their needs.
