FISK AND ROBINSON IN BANKRUPTCY

NEW YORK, N. Y., Feb. 2—Fisk and Robinson, bond dealers and members of the New York Stock Exchange, failed for a million dollars today. An involuntary petition in bankruptcy was filed by creditors in the United States district Court late this afternoon and Bronson Winthrop was appointed receiver with a bond of \$30,000, shrinkage in the value of railroad bonds held by the firm caused the failure.

The failure is one of the largest since the panic of 1907, not so much as liabilities are concerned, but in view of the importance of the firm, which has branches in Chicago, Boston and Worcester, Mass. The firm was founded in 1889 by Harvey Edward Fisk, the eldest son of Harvey Fisk, the banker, and George N. Robinson, who had been in the employ of the banking firm of Harvey Fisk and Sons.
