Synopsis of Canadian Northwest Land Regulations.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family or who is over 18 years of age, may become a settler and acquire a section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Land Agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any Agency, on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of the settler.

Duties:—The residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead or at least 80 acres fully owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section along side his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties:—Must reside six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to earn homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres.

A homesteader who has exhausted his home-land right and cannot obtain a pre-emption may also purchase homestead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties:—Must reside six months in each of three years, and cultivate fifty acres.
