ROSEBERY AND WILLIAM PITT.

Lord Rosebery seems to possess some of the qualities he attributes to the subject of his recently published biography, Lord Chatham: His Early Life and Connections; for, like William Pitt, he follows his own political courses in a way that is variously interpreted as independence or eccentricity. Cable despatches this week show a striking case of this. His turning against the measure for the reform of the house of lords proposed by Lord Lansdowne shows that, like Pitt, he is indifferent to the charge of inconsistency. Lord Rosebery, however, is perhaps better known in another character he assigns to Pitt; alleging that its assumption was a notable mark in his career—that of "the dextrous official diplomatist, coaxing the reassuring."

DOMESTIC ROWS

The National Labor Tribune makes Miss Rosa McQuade, probation officer in the Domestic Relations Court in New York city, say: "Women nag more the men, but a man's dog-nag can beat any woman at it." It is also said to be her opinion that when husband and wife get at logger-heads that nothing will do but a "visit to the judge," the best course is to visit the home, to quietly interview husband and wife separately, give good advice, and report how to case stands to the judge, in order that he may know what the final decision in the case should be. 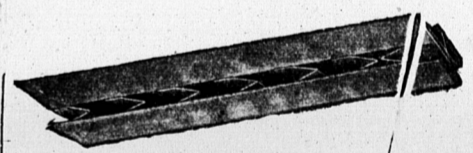

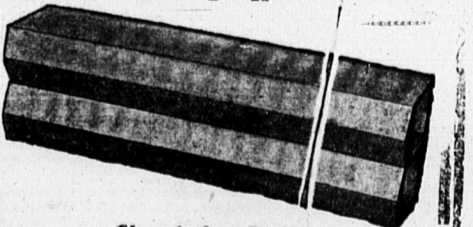
