MAN ON TRIAL FOR ROBBERY

TORONTO, Sept. 1.—Frank Diehin, better known as Fritzie Chapman, one of the slickest crooks in America, is in the cells here on his way to Chatham, Ont., to stand trial for stealing \$1,575 cash, and a number of checks and drafts, the property of the now defunct Sovereign bank on December 1st, 1906. Diehin and a confederate spotted the bank clerk, knew his weekly route, and by a clever ruse substituted one of their own bags for the one the clerk used.

Diehin was arrested and is serving three years in Kingston. Diehin escaped and last July was arrested for attempting to steal a diamond from one of the Biks at the big convention in Passadena. After the arrest he was identified as one of the operators who stole the bank's money and after fighting extradition was ordered to Chatham for trial. He is now in charge of Lieut. R. A. Stent, of Detroit, Mich., and Constable Mahoney of Chatham, Ont.
