TRURO, Dec. 1.—After being out two hours, the jury in the case of E. J. Perry, charged with murder of Mrs. Maud Wright, returned a verdict of manslaughter in the first degree, and Mr. Justice Drysdale sentenced the prisoner to twenty years in the penitentiary.

The evidence showed that there had been a struggle between Perry and the woman who lived with him, and that Perry had cut her throat with a razor.

Perry was at one time a resident of Charlottetown and always known as "a bad egg."
