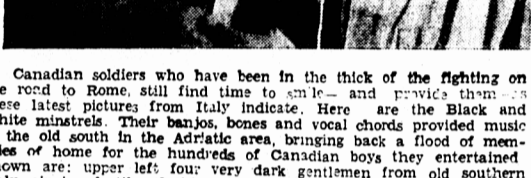

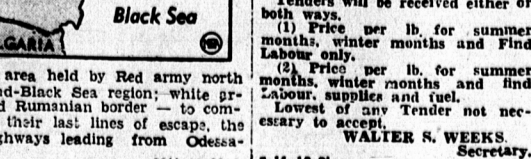
Map showing shipping routes and locations in the Bismarck Sea region, including New Ireland, Rabaul, and Milne Bay.
