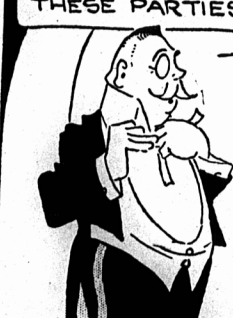

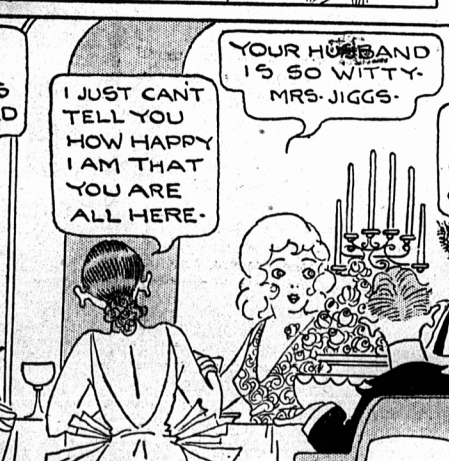


YES, MY LOVE-
