FARM POULTRY

Poultry Notes, submitted by Poultry Division, Dominion Live Stock Branch. This information given in the interests of better farm flocks. All inquiries to be addressed to Box 200, Charlottetown.

More interest in poultry, and poultry products, is shown from year to year. Many farmers a few years ago considered poultry as a necessary evil, and not in any sense of the word as revenue makers.

The writer, in the following articles, will endeavor to give in concise form the results of their experience covering many years. Success or failure in keeping poultry depends upon breeding, feeding, hatching, rearing, sanitation and general management.

We do not mean that the keeping of poultry is extremely difficult, but we do wish to impress upon our readers that it is no business for a lazy or indifferent person, or one who is not prepared to plan the work carefully, and then work to the plan.

GENERAL PURPOSE BREEDS. Plymouth Rocks. There are six varieties of this breed, three of which are common. Barred, White, Buff, Silver Laced, Golden Laced, Black Columbian, Partridge and Silver Pencilled.

Rhode Island Reds. There are two varieties of this breed, single comb, and rose comb. As compared with the Plymouth Rocks and Wyandottes they are larger in appearance, and not so massive. They were originated by the farmers of the State of Rhode Island, and are very popular in that State.

BREEDS OF POULTRY. The present high price of eggs and meat has done much to popularize poultry on the farm, and consequently we are frequently asked as to what is the best breed of poultry. It is impossible to answer this question, as some of the breeds are special purpose breeds, and others general purpose.

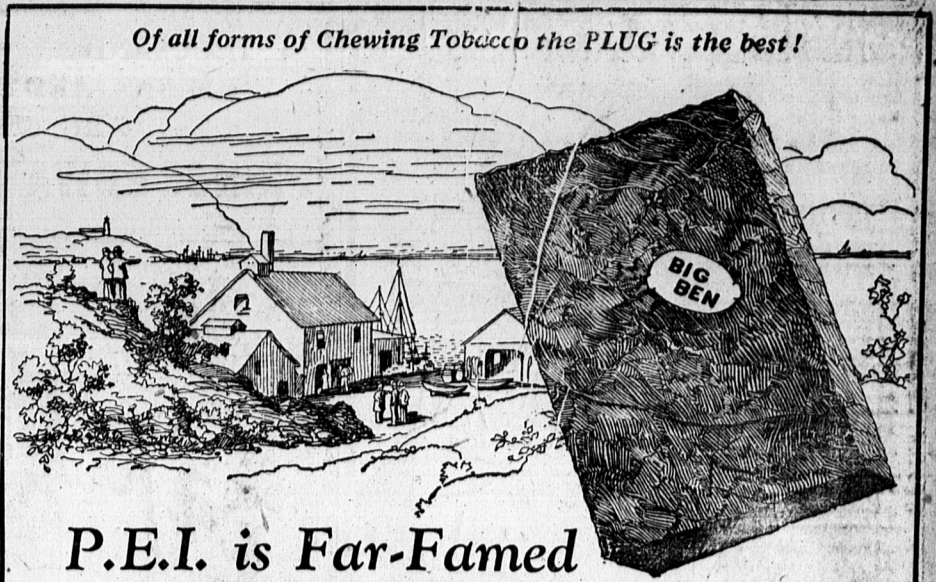
