Synopsis of Canadian Northwest Land Regulations

THE sole head of a family or any male over eighteen years of age, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the District. Entry by proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency but not Sub-Agency on certain conditions. A settler who has exhausted his homestead right may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties—Six months residence in each of three years after earning homestead; also 50 acres extra cultivation. Pre-emption patent may be obtained as soon as homestead patent, on certain conditions. A Romance Of The War

Former Rector of Sandringham, Domestic Chaplain to King George and Honorary Chaplain to Queen Alexandra, Dismissed From His Court Posts, Has Emerged From War Purged of Disgrace.

NEW YORK, Nov. 12.—The Evening World says today: Another man has emerged from the European war purged of disgrace, according to information received today. Fred P. Farrar, of the French Foreign Legion, has been decorated for valor in the field and acclaimed for conspicuous gallantry. He disappeared five years ago, and his friends here and in England learned that, as the Rev. Frederick Percival Farrar, rector of Sandringham, domestic chaplain to Queen Alexandra, Queen Dowager of Great Britain, he had been dismissed from his court posts. He had not been heard of since he left the United States or England until a few days ago.

For a year he has been fighting in the Foreign Legion, but it is not known under what name. His persistent courage finally drew attention to him. In addition to other honors, it is understood, he was offered a commission in the British army by the King, but declined, preferring to fight in the ranks with his present comrades. The former rector's wife was Miss Nora Davis, a sister of the late Richard Harding Davis. He met her when he was a Philadelphia newspaper reporter and they had been married only five months when his disgrace came.

GOVERNMENT AND COSTS OF LIVING.

OTTAWA, Nov. 12.—The full text of the government order-in-council designed to control the cost of living in Canada shows that the new regulations are much more drastic than anticipated.

There is distinct provision against the accumulation of food products, save as are required in the ordinary course of business. Under the combined act it was made an offence to "unduly" enhance the price of commodities by means of combination. In the order now passed as regards the necessities of life "unduly" is eliminated and any combination or agreement to enhance the price of food or clothing or fuel is made a criminal offence. It is made an offence to agree to limit facilities for transporting, producing, manufacturing, storing or dealing in any necessary of life; to strain or injure trade or commerce in relation to any necessary of life; to prevent, limit or lessen the manufacture or production of any such commodity.

Wide powers are conferred upon the Minister of Labor, whose department will be the medium of action for the federal government, while extensive authority is likewise given to municipal authorities, which is empowered to expand production of full business returns from any person or firm, under oath, which it is suspected exceeds prices are being demanded. The Minister of Labor has the same power. The order-in-council defines as "necessary of life," a staple or ordinary

DEPORTATIONS OF BELGIANS CAUSE RIOTS IN BRUSSELS.

LONDON, Nov. 12.—A despatch to Reuter's Telegram Company from Amsterdam says: "The Telegraaf's frontier correspondent reports that placards were posted at Antwerp last Saturday summing citizens from seventeen to thirty years of age to hold themselves ready to depart. He adds that 30,000 Belgians already have been removed from Antwerp to Germany. They receive 3 marks weekly with military rations. Several riots have occurred.

"Les Nouvelles prints a Maastricht despatch saying that there are persistent rumors that the deportations have provoked a revolt at Brussels in the course of which thirty Germans were killed or seriously wounded and there were numerous Belgian casualties. The city of Brussels is closed and nobody is permitted to enter or leave."

London, Nov. 10.—The Echo Belge as quoted by Reuter's Amsterdam correspondent, says that according to the latest news the Germans have transported 21,000 citizens of Antwerp to Germany.

A great panic prevails in Antwerp and in the surrounding country, adds the newspaper, which reports also that three women who tried to cross the Dutch frontier were killed by a shock from the electric wire barrier on the border.
