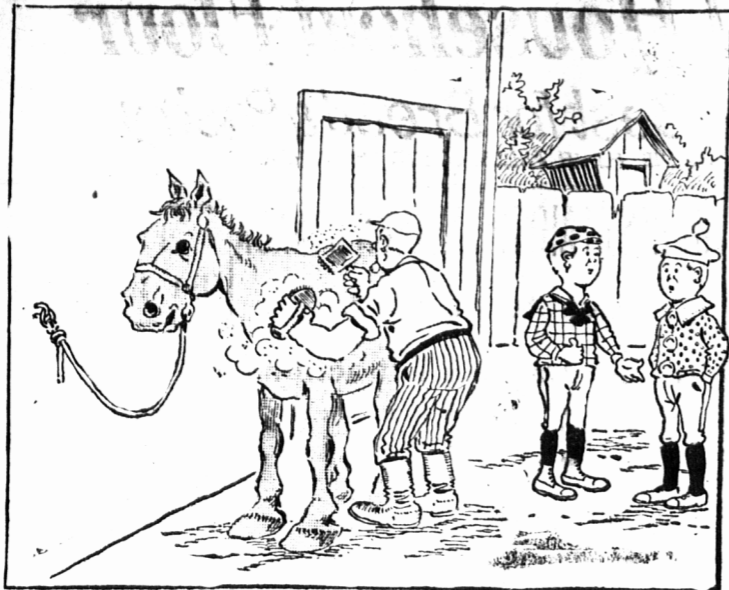
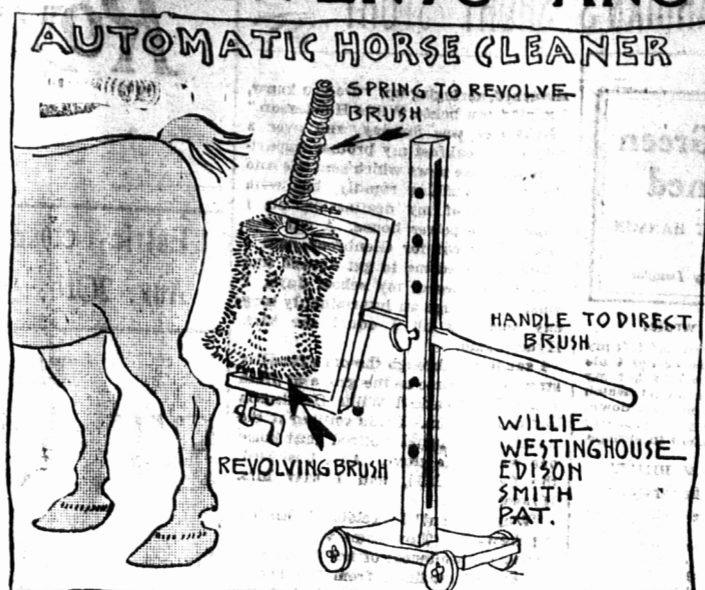


WILLIE WESTINGHOUSE INVENTS ANOTHER LABOR-SAVER



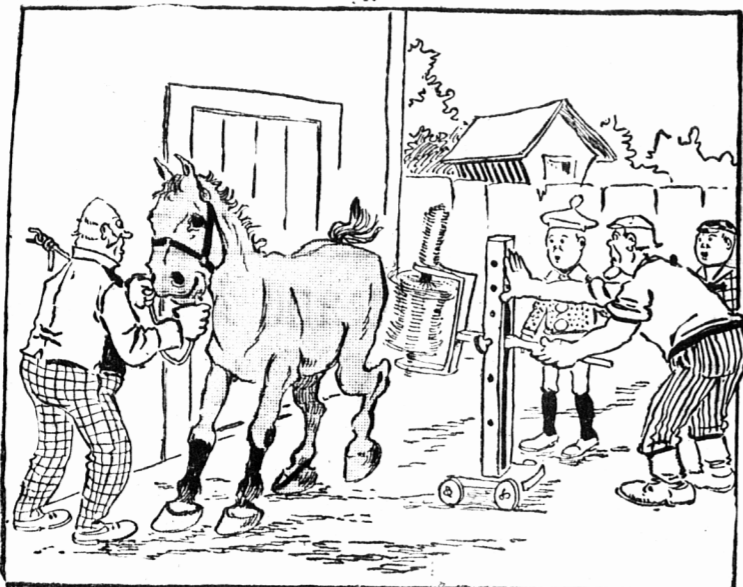
Dear Mamma: Every morning Uncle Tom's hired man has to clean the horses.



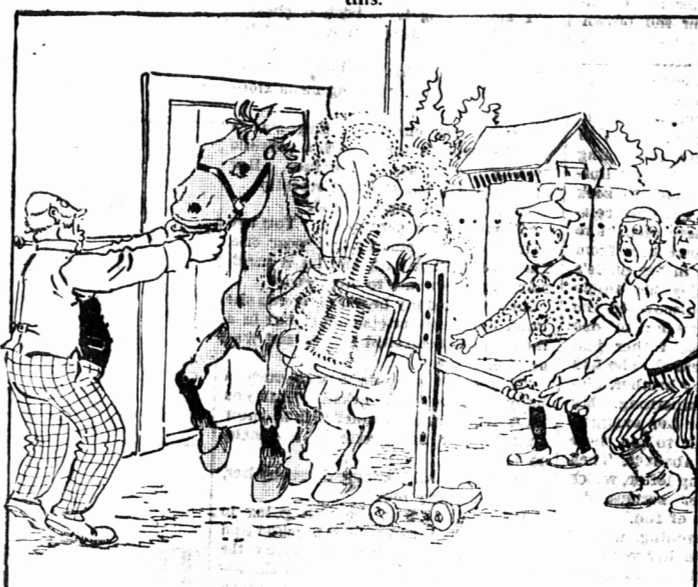
As it is a slow process doing it by hand, I made an automatic brush like this.



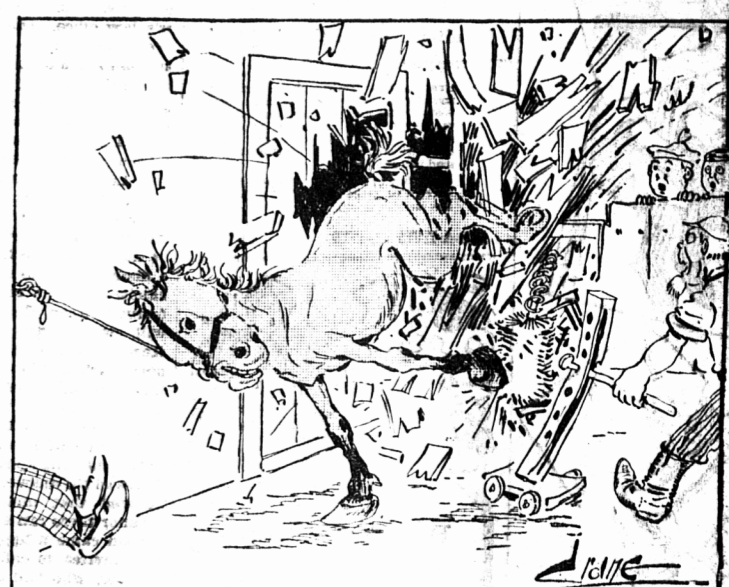
We tried it on old Dobbin and he seemed to like it.
