NOVA SCOTIA MEN DEAD FROM POISON

Dr. J. L. Peppard, of Great Village, and Samuel Lindsay of Londonderry, Took Strychnine in Mistake For Fruit Syrup to Quench Thirst.

HALIFAX, Sept. 23.—Dr. J. L. Peppard, of Great Village and Samuel Lindsay, of Londonderry Station, died from the effects of poisoning Saturday afternoon. The men were at work harvesting oats and, becoming thirsty, went to the house for a drink of buttermilk. When entering the door the doctor said, "We'll have something better than buttermilk," so they went into the office. On the shelf were two bottles, one containing strychnine and the other fruit syrup. When the men had quenched their thirst they went back to the field. Dr. Peppard was driving the rake when he

reeled and fell from the seat, calling to the boy who was working with him to get him a drink of mustard and warm water. The boy ran to the house but in his excitement forgot the message. Mrs. Peppard came running to her husband's assistance but before she could do anything for him he was dead.

In the meantime Samuel Lindsay, who was working in another part of the field, became sick. He was taken to the house, where he lingered until about 5 o'clock on Saturday. Lindsay belonged to Londonderry Station.

Synopsis of Canadian North-West HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

ANY even numbered section of Dominion Land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting s. and 20, may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any man over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section, 160 acres, more or less.

Entry must be made, personally at the local land office for the district in which the land is situated.

The homesteader is required to perform the conditions connected therewith, under one of the following plans.

(1) At least six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years.

(2) If the father for mother, if the father is deceased or the homesteader resides upon a farm in the vicinity of the land entered for the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by such persons residing with the father or mother.

(3) If the settler has his permanent residence upon farming land owned by him in the vicinity of his homestead, the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the said land.

Six months notice in writing should be given to the Comptroller of Dominion Land (Ottawa) of intention to apply for release. W. W. CORY, Deputy of the Interior, N. B.—Unauthorized publication of this advertisement will not be paid for 6-27d3m

ANNEX UNGAVA TO QUEBEC PROVINCE

Premier Gouin Announces This as an Election Campaign Slogan. Will Demand That Vast Unorganized Area to the North Be Given Away.

MONTEAL, Sept. 23.—Premier Gouin, in a political meeting at Longueuil this afternoon that his new program included a demand for the annexation to Quebec province of the whole immense territory of Ungava.

MONCTON HAS MORE TROUBLE

MONCTON, Sept. 23.—The City Council is experiencing much difficulty in keeping Scott Act Inspector Adam Dickson, who was brought here from Chatham nearly two months ago to enforce the Scott Act. He tendered his resignation last night to Ald. Crandall, chairman of the police committee, to take effect October ninth. Dickson's enforcement of the act was not satisfactory to the temperance people, but his own dissatisfaction with the job led to his resignation. He was formerly chief of police at Chatham.

which would make this by far the largest province of the dominion.

Premier Gouin pointed out that the territory of Ungava was entirely separated from all the other provinces by great inland seas and offered no advantages to any of them except Quebec, so there could be no objection to its annexation. This province, he contended, was in a better position than the Ottawa government to administer the district of Ungava, so that the annexation would be a benefit to the dominion as well as this province.

Hon. Mr. Gouin also severely criticized Mr. Bourassa, whose speeches, he said, he could not understand nor did he believe that Bourassa understood them either. He intimated that Mr. Bourassa had been jockeying for a provincial portfolio, and when he found he could not get it he had started his campaign against the provincial government.

A very large portion of the premier's speech was directed to a criticism of Mr. Bourassa and his program. The meeting was a very large one, fully 6,000 people attending and the Ungava announcement was loudly cheered.

It looks as though this might be one of the election slogans next year.

MORE CHEERFUL FEELING NOW

New York, Sept. 23.—A most cheerful feeling over the financial outlook has emerged through the clouds which remained over the prospect as revealed in the movement of the stock market.

These clouds were gathered for the most part over the metal industries, especially copper and the securities of that group have created a conviction that the unfavorable condition has been adequately discounted and that a better situation might be forthcoming. The price of copper has made further decline and plans for radical curtailment of output have been officially announced by the great producers. The demand for the metal at the reduced price has not yet been emphatic, but hopes are expressed that the level of stability in the trade is near and that the withheld demand will develop and the market right itself.

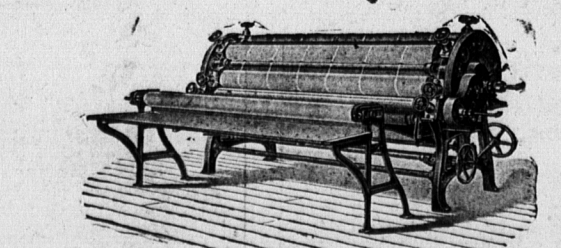

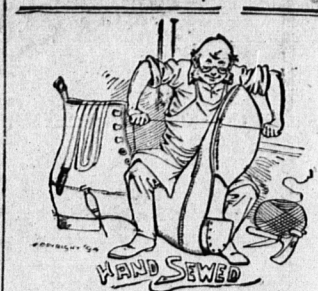
