THE GUARDIAN'S WEEK END SERMON

Sermon by Rev. J. W. Aikens.

"What doth the Lord require of thee but to do justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with thy God?" Micah 6-8.

The wise man has said that "to do justice and judgment is more acceptable to God than sacrifice." God sets a high value upon the just man. No amount of praying will atone for an act of injustice. God sees every unjust act, word, and deed. "If thou seest the oppression of the poor and violent perverting of judgment and justice in a province, marvel not at the matter for he that is higher than the highest regardeth." The searchlight of public opinion, slowly but surely, is turned on every unjust act. In Leviticus we are exhorted to do no unrighteousness in judgment, in measure, in weight, in measure; just balances and just weights shall ye have. No man can get right with God or keep right before God who knowingly defrauds others in business. I have read of a travelling salesman who in a certain morning sought pardon for his sins but could find no peace. By and by he arose and seizing a stick that he used as a cane, smashed it across his knee. Then he obtained pardon, for the cane was also his yard-stick which by constant use had become an inch less than three feet in length, so that he cheated his customers each time that he measured cloth. Masters are commanded to give unto their servants that which is just and equal "knowing that you have a master in heaven." Everything must be measured and done in the light of heaven. Are we doing justly with servants in regard to their spiritual welfare? A servant gave as her reason for leaving her situation, "I must take care of my soul and in this place, I have no opportunity to attend church on Sunday." Sunday should be more of a fast day than a feast-day. This would be a preparation for hearing the gospel and also give opportunity

for everybody to worship God on the Sabbath day. What about the wages that servants receive? "Behold the hire of your laborers who have reaped down your fields which is of you kept back by fraud and their cries have entered into the ears of the Lord of Sabbath." I remember till this day the sense of injustice that I felt many years ago, when after laboring hard for a man, who after promising me a dollar for a day's work in the harvest field, dismissed me in the evening by saying—"I'll do as much for you some time." He still owes for that day's work.

The Bible frequently refers to the duty of justice to the poor. "The King that faithfully judgeth the poor, his throne shall be established for ever." It is hard sometimes for a poor man to get justice, for lawsuits cost money. Someone has said you can win any case if you have \$25,000.

One of the healthy signs of the times is the fact that there are so many rich and prominent criminals behind prison bars. It is hard to prosecute rich rum-sellers for they are able to carry their case from court to court until poor corporations become financially embarrassed. This is one reason why all temperance legislation should be backed up by the consolidated revenues of the province or dominion.

The poor man should not be crowded in business. Here is a poor dealer in tinware, trying to make an honest living. In the course of time the proprietors of a big department store in that city takes up this line of goods and because they can make a good profit on other lines they begin to undersell the poor neighbor with the result that he is soon compelled to give up altogether. That is an act of injustice. God has said "When you reap your field ye shall not wholly reap the corners of it." We should give the poor man a chance to make a living. Verily in this case the destruction of the poor is their own fault. The modern trust is denounced in Isaiah 5-8. "Woe unto them that join house to house, that lay field to field, till there be no place that they may be placed upon in the midst of the earth."

In Exodus it is written—"there shall not rise a false witness with very possible to deal unjustly with people by giving wrong impressions about them. We may repeat the very words that another has said but do it in such a way as to give an altogether different meaning. That is dishonesty as surely as is the theft of money. The tongue of the just is as choice as silver." Be just for it lies at the foundation of good character. When people cease to be just they are tampering with the foundation. "Love mercy." This follows justice for where there is no justice there can be no mercy. Some people abolish justice in attempting to be merciful. The Bible principle is as merciful as silver. "He that spareth his son but he that loveth his chasteneth him betimes." What some have called mercy, God has termed hatred. The principle that applies to the family also applies to the State.

Years ago in this province a man was killed in a drunken row. The murderer escaped through leniency, and for many years ran one of the worst dives in the country, with the inevitable result that his own family have been disgraced and damned. One son is now in the penitentiary for a crime committed through the use of liquor, one daughter has committed suicide, and one of the family have turned

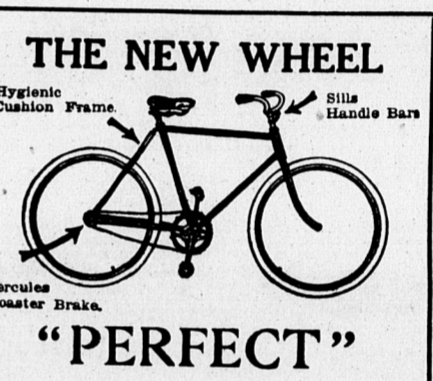
