WORKMEN LOST A PAYING JOB

HALIFAX, N. S. Aug. 4.—The New York parties who have taken the contract to repair the steamer Mystic at present in the dry dock, brought five workmen here today from New York with the necessary working tools, and the men started to work yesterday making temporary repairs to the ship which the Halifax mechanics refused to do.

Before starting the representative of the New York concern, secured the services of several police officers and stationed them at the dock, fearing that the local men might cause trouble. This in itself is considered by the Halifax dock management a high handed act as no permission was asked from the dock company for the placing of policemen on their premises.

The taking away of this vessel will mean a great loss to the city mechanics as it would have taken at least a month to repair her. It is reported that the New York dock company have taken the contract to have the steamer repaired in twenty-three days and will forfeit \$250 a day for every day over that time.
