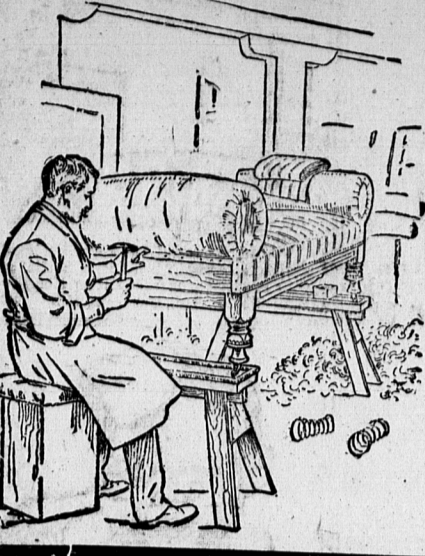

CANADA'S BIG BANK PROFITS WERE \$1,797,000

Bank of Montreal's Annual Statement Was Given Out To-day

Canada's premier bank issued its annual statement today, and it was fully up to expectations. The net profits for the year amounted to \$1,797,992, compared with \$1,826,167 a year ago.

After paying the usual dividends, which called for \$1,440,000, the big bank carries forward the large sum of \$661,789.

The statement will be submitted to the Bank of Montreal shareholders at the annual meeting on December 5th.

The most striking changes in the statement are shown by the increase in interest bearing deposits, the decrease in call loans outside of Canada and the increase in current loans. This indicates that the bank has withdrawn a good deal of outside money loaned on stocks, etc., and placed it here to assist general commercial operations.
