PROFIT SHARING SCHEME OF STEEL CORPORATION.

NEW YORK, Jan. 14.—In accordance with its profit-sharing plan of the past nine years, the United States Steel Corporation made known the terms and conditions under which officers and employees of the corporation and its subsidiaries may subscribe for additional preferred and common shares for the current year.

Under this plan employees receiving between \$2,000 and \$5,000 may subscribe for more than one share of the preferred, while those receiving between \$2,000 and \$3,000 may subscribe for as many as fifteen shares. Of the common stock employees earning under \$500 are limited to one share, with a maximum of 25 shares for the highest-priced employees or officials.

STOCKHOLM, Jan. 17.—Women henceforth are to take their full share with men in the political life of Sweden. The speech from the Throne at the opening of the Riksdag yesterday contained an announcement that a bill will be introduced enfranchising women and making women eligible in all elections to the Rikstag on the same conditions as men.
